Dear Sir,

I was an employee of the US Government in Viet Nam prior to 1975. Following are the details of my services :

-from Jan.3, 1966 to June 1969 : I served with the CIDG Security Force Camp John F. Mc Dermott in Nha Trang province, APO 96240, as a security guard, Hung force. Later I was promoted to M/Sgt by the US Advisors such as Capt. Donald J. Church, Capt. Kasner, Capt. Jose De Voronda and Capt. Jose Dorta.

-Then I was transferred to RMK-BRJ working as a worker for 5 months.

-From 1971 to 1972 : I again served for the USAF RV, NACPO, APO 96240, 577th Engineer Battalion, 585th Engineer Company, APO 96204, as a guard (Squad Leader). I served for this unit until the withdrawal of US Forces in Di Linh (VN)

Total period of service : over 5 years.

I and my family would be very obliged if you could grant us a Letter of Introduction in order to enable us to present it to the Vietnamese authorities to apply for exit permit.

For the sake of humanity and due to the present difficult situation of my family (we have lived in a rural area very far from the town and working as the farmers, often lack of food and medicine, clothes) as to help us be permitted to migrate in USA under the humanitarian policy of the US Government .

Should further documents be needed, please advise me for I can submit

Thank you deeply for your ~~kind~~ attention to this case and hope to hear from you soon.
