My name is Tran My, a former political prisoner of the vietnamese communist regime. I am currently residing at
CANOGA PARK CA. 91306

And this is my phone number:

Before april 1975, I was a Second lieutenant, deputy great company, battalion 3/318, City GIA DINH, in the armed forces of the Republic of Vietnam.

After the communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a re-education camp from 5-11-1975 to 4-1976 LAM SON, KHANH HOA.

4-1976 - 3-1978, at: K 54 - PHU YEN

3-1978 - 06-21-81 at A 30 - PHU YEN

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the united States on 4-23-1996 in accordance with a subprogram of the orderly Departure program for former political prisoners under a bilateral agreement between Vietnam and the united states. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the united States, my resettlement has been made extremely difficult, because the following unmarried children of mine have been rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years unmarried children were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoner.
