Dear Ma'am,

I, the undersigned TRAN VAN BE NAM, 55 years old, former Political Prisoner of the Vietnamese Communist Regime.

I am currently residing at:

Before April, 1975, I was Sergeant of Engineer Battalion, Marine Corps in the Armed Forces of the Republic of Vietnam.

After the Communists came to take power, I was imprisoned in A-20 Xuan Phuoc re-education Camp in Tuy Hoa, Phu Khanh Province from 10/25/1975 to 02/21/1980.

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the United States on 07/23/1996 at New York Port in accordance with a subprogram of the ODP Program for former Political Prisoners under a bilateral Agreement between Vietnam and the United States. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been made extremely difficult on account of the fact that the following unmarried children of mine have been denied for resettlement despite the fact that for many years the unmarried children were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoners:

1. TRAN VAN PHUNG was born on 01-16-1970
2. TRAN LE TRUC HA was born on 12-23-1971
3. TRAN THUY DOAN TIANG was born on 12-26-1973

Thus, I hope you can help me, so that, our family could be reunited together again. In particular, may I urge that you give your support to Section 595 of the Foreign Operations Appropriation Bill HR. 3540 offered by Senator JOHN Mc CAIN and enacted by the Senate on July 26, 1996. The bill will be considered by the Conference Committee in early September, 1996. By making sure that this Section remains in the final Act, you will be helping many families of former Vietnamese Political Prisoners who are in the same sad situation as mine.
