Dear Senator Charles Wilson,

My name is Vo-CHAU-NGOC, date of birth 03-11-1927, a former political prisoner of the Vietnamese communist regime. I am currently residing at Dallas-Tx. 75228,

Before April 1975, I was a captain Chief Police District Binh-don, Dongai, in the armed forces of the Republic of Viet-nam. After the communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a reeducation camp from since 11-27-1975 to come 01-18-1982 in concentration camp Xuan-phuoc.

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the United States on 8-22-1995 in accordance with a subprogram of the orderly departure program for former political prisoners under a bilateral agreement between Viet-nam and the United States. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been made extremely difficult because the following unmarried children of mine have been rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years unmarried children were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoners:

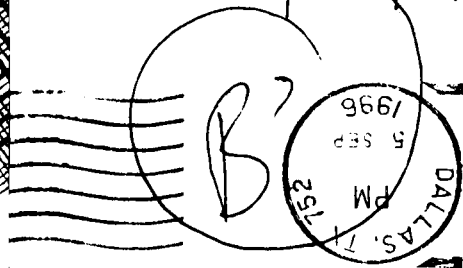
