RE: Complaint concerning my son being denied privilege to come to the United States.

Dear Madam;

I am writting to ask for your help, my name is Si Vo, I was born on 8-8-42. My wife's name is Rum Thi Nguyen. Her date of birth is 8-18-51. We are currently US residents.

When we filed the document for H. O., we had 2 unmarried children. Our daughter, Phu Thi Vo and our son. Quan Thanh Vo. On 12-12-1995 my wife and I had been called for an interview with the U.S. official and we both passed, however, our children were both over the age of 21 and were not able to interview with us. Since then, our daughter was married on 2-18-1997 our children had been called for an Interview and both have been denied. She does not wish to leave Vietnam. However, our son does. I went to have my blood type tested as a requirement for the interview for my son to come to the U.S. the results of the test are included with this letter.

On 1-27-99, our son was callled for a re-interview, but was denied. The Vietnamese interpreter told our son that the reason is due to the fact that they did not have his mother s blood type on file. When I went to have my blood type tested, they did not request my wife to do the same.

We would really appreciate any guidance you can give us in this matter. What can we do so that our son can get reconsider at this time? Thank you very much for any help you can give to us.

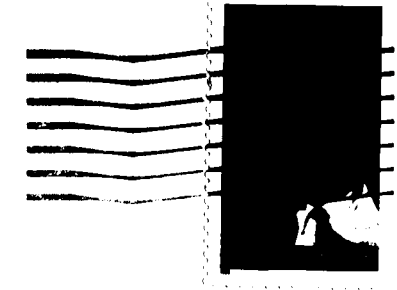
