We need the following documents to complete your file. Please send us clear, legible copies of the documents checked below. Do not send originals; do not send us documents we have not checked.

BE SURE TO MARK ALL PAPERS WITH THE FILE NUMBER (IV NUMBER) WRITTEN ABOVE.

(1) One copy of the original birth certificate (giay khai sinh) of yourself and of each family member to accompany you, or of:

Vu Thanh Phong

(2) One copy of the original of your marriage certificate (giay hon thu).
If you are now married

NOTE: A cohabitation certificate (chung chi song chuong) is not acceptable. Also, if you or any other family member was previously married, we need evidence that the previous marriage was lawfully ended: one copy of the death certificate (giay chung tu) of the former spouse(s), or one copy of the divorce decree (giay ly di).

(3) Copies of pre-1975 government identity (ID) cards (the can cuoc) of yourself and of all family members who were born prior to 1960, as well as copies of the post-1975 cards.

(4) Copies of post-1975 government identity (ID) cards (giay chung minh nhan dan) of yourself and of all family members who have been issued such ID cards.

(5) One copy of the original of your household census book (ho khau).

NOTE: (1-5) Birth and marriage certificates and other documents are available from the local authorities. Please go to the authorities who keep the original records and request official copies. We have received enough documents to indicate nearly all pre-1975 civil registries have been preserved.

(6) One original, individual photograph of yourself and of each family member. Write the name and file (IV) number of each person on the back of his/her photo. (Total: _____ photos).

(7) Copies of papers which show that you or other family members worked for the U.S. government or for a private U.S. company.

(8) Copies of papers which show that you or other family members studied or were trained in the U.S., or in another country under U.S. sponsorship

(9) Copies of papers which show that you or other family members worked closely with U.S. officials or U.S. programs while working for the Vietnamese government or serving in the Vietnamese military.

(10) Copies of certificates or awards received from the U.S. government.

(11) Copies of papers which show your position, rank, or function in the Vietnamese civil service or military.

NOTE: The papers requested in items 7 to 11 can be personnel actions, payroll slips, certificates, awards, ID cards, travel orders, passports, letters of commendation, or similar documents. Also send the names of American supervisors or advisors, or copies of any letters you have received from them.

(12) One copy of the ^{original} reeducation release certificate (giay ra trai) of
Vu Thanh Phong
