Gentlemen

I undersigned former 1st Lieutenant LY VAN QUANG of Medical Corps, ARVN of The Republic of South Vietnam before April 30th 1975, representative for some of the former officers and non-commissioned officers of the old regime in Saigon.

We all are the boat people in many different trips leaving from our homeland because of genuine fear of repression and arrived Thailand country before and after the deadline, March 14th which ASEAN countries had set. We have been now collected in Khao I Dang Holding Center for some time to be moved later to Area Control Ban Thad Center and had to wait until screening procedures begin following an international conference on refugees in next June in Geneva.

Dear Sir,

Almost all of us had to be detained in reeducation camp, repressed in many other ways during last time. We had tried to leave out of Vietnam many times nothing but in vain and had been kept in jailhouses.

We are now in a country with freedom and are regarded as illegal migrants as papers said it would be.

We always wish to be admitted for immigration in The United States, an allied and friendly country against communism, under the auspices of the ODP.

We shall be grateful if it will be paid attention to interfere with the US commission in the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), so we might be screened as soon as possible and be eligible for resettlement abroad, especially in The United States.
