**AMENDMENT TO H.R. (SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS BILL)**

The Omnibus Consolidated Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 1997, P.L. 104-208, is hereby amended as follows:

In section 584 of section 101(c), the Foreign Operations, Export Financing, and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 1997,

(1) in subsection (a), by striking "year 1997" and inserting "years 1997 and 1998"; and

(2) in subparagraph (b)(1)(A), by inserting after "Socialist Republic of Vietnam" in subparagraph (b)(1)(A): ", or is the widow or widower of such a former internee"; and

(3) in subparagraph (b)(1)(B), by striking the text from "has" through "April 1, 1995" and inserting in its place "qualified for refugee processing under the former re-education camp internees subprogram of the Orderly Departure Program and has been accepted for resettlement as a refugee or for admission as an immediate relative or special immigrant, or, if deceased, whose widow or widower has been accepted for resettlement or admission under the Orderly Departure Program on or after April 1, 1995".
