
I am writing to ask your special attention to the case of Mr. Nguyen Thanh Chiou (IV-0093091/R110324).

Mr. Nguyen Thanh Chiou was born Thanh Thong Hoang, DOB: June 12, 1930, a former journalist, former chairman of the Vietnamese Journalist Association (1969-1973), was put in the "re-education camp" from 1976 to 1984.

On January 27, 1996 in Ho Chi Minh city, Mr. Nguyen met with the U.S. Interview Team, who announced him eligible to attend an interview and suggested he apply for exit permit from the Vietnamese authorities and return to the U.S. after getting the exit permission. But his application for exit permit was rejected by the Vietnamese officials on the ground of being

involved in the 1962-1963 coup attempt in the U.S. based on agreement between the U.S. and the Vietnamese government.

Mr. Nguyen is a writer and a journalist, known by registering Vietnamese writers abroad.


On January 27, 1996 in Ho-Chi-Minh city, Mr. Nguyen met with the U.S. Interview Team, who announced him eligible to attend an interview and suggested he apply for exit permission from the Vietnamese authorities and return to be interviewed after getting the exit permission. But his application for exit permission was later denied by the Vietnamese officials on the ground of being "writers of the old regime".

Mr. Nguyen Thanh Chiêu is eligible to emigrate to the U.S. based on agreements between Việt Nam and the U.S. government.

Would you please be so kind as to help Mr. Nguyen by suggesting Vietnamese authorities issue him exit permission.

Dear Mr. Dirrector,

My name is Nguyen Thanh Chieu, pen name Thanh Thuong Hoang, born on June 12, 1930, current residence at 872 Journalist block, An Phu village, Thu Duc district, Ho-chi-Minh city. Before 1975, I was a writer and journalist, and former chairman of the Vietnamese Journalist Trade Union.

On January 27, 1996, I was referred by the Foreign Relation Office in Ho-chi-Minh city to contact the US Interview Team where I was informed that I was eligible for an interview (copy enclosed). The US Interview Team also suggest me apply for exit permission from Vietnamese authorities and bring it back, not to send it by mail.

Later, I submitted the application for exit permission at NO. 6 Nguyen Du street, Ho-chi-Minh city. But I was denied by a female officer, who said no visa be issued for the writers belong to the old regime.

The purpose of this letter is to report to you the above problem and to say thank you for trying to help me to be resettled in USA, that I wish very much to.

Thưa Ông Giám Đốc,

Tôi là Nguyễn Thanh Chiêu bút hiệu Thanh Thương Hoàng, sinh ngày 12/06/1930 -thường trú tại 872 Khu Báo Chí, xã An Phú, huyện Thủ Đức, thành phố Hồ Chí Minh - trước năm 1975, viết văn và viết báo, nguyên chủ tịch Nghiệp Đoàn Ký Giả Việt Nam, trân trọng kính tin Ông rõ :

Ngày 27/1/1996, tôi được Sở Ngoại Vụ thành phố Hồ Chí Minh mời tới tiếp xúc với phái đoàn Hoa Kỳ. Trong cuộc tiếp xúc tôi được cho biết là đã hội đủ điều kiện để được phỏng vấn (đính kèm bản sao) . Phái đoàn yêu cầu tôi nộp hồ sơ xin phép xuất cảnh với nhà chức trách Việt Nam và khi có giấy phép xuất cảnh hãy trực tiếp mang tới cho phái đoàn tránh việc gửi qua đường bưu điện sợ thất lạc.

Sau đó tôi làm hồ sơ xin phép xuất cảnh nộp tại số 6 Nguyễn Du, thành phố Hồ Chí Minh. Bà Thượng úy công an, phụ trách nhận hồ sơ, sau khi xem hồ sơ của tôi xong đã trả lại hồ sơ và cho biết là có lệnh không cấp hộ chiếu cho những người thuộc diện Văn nghệ sỹ của chế độ cũ đi HO.

Vậy tôi kính tin Ông Giám Đốc biết đồng thời xin trân trọng cảm ơn Ông Giám Đốc và các viên chức chương trình ra đi có trật tự đã có thiện ý trong việc cho tôi tái định cư tại Hoa Kỳ, một điều mà tôi rất mong muốn.
