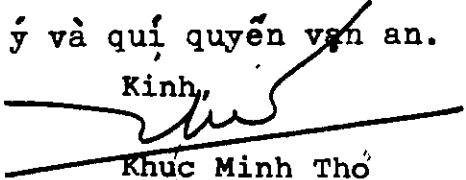

Dear Senator Leahy:

We are writing to seek your support for an amendment to redress a major problem we are having with the processing of the families of the former Vietnamese political prisoners by the Orderly Departure Program (ODP).

Amendment No. 5064 to the Foreign Operations Appropriations bill HR 3540 was offered by Senator John McCain and enacted by the Senate on July 26, 1996. The bill will be considered by the Conference Committee early during the week of July 29, 1996.

As you know, our Association, the Families of the Vietnamese Political Prisoners Association (FVPPA), has worked on behalf of the former political prisoners and their families since 1977. After 12 years, a long wait, the HO subprogram of ODP for the former political prisoners and their families began in 1989. The agreement signed by the governments of Vietnam and the United States provided for the resettlement of the former political prisoners and their "close family members".

However, after almost six years of operation, the State Department abruptly decided that, effective April 1995, ODP would no longer permit unmarried adult sons and daughters to accompany their parents to the United States.

This amendment will continue the resettlement of the former political prisoners and their families based on family unity and values.

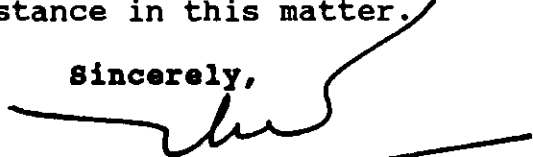

We strongly feel that this family eligibility change so late in the program is unfair and unacceptable. Those who have been involved with the HO subprogram of ODP from the beginning understand that this is a unique program for the long suffering former political prisoners. To break-up the families who have suffered years of separation in the past and have waited years for resettlement is to deny many former political prisoners the chance to resettle in the United States as a family.

For many years you have always been a strong supporter of our association and embraced our efforts to provide assistance to our loved ones and the former Vietnamese political prisoners. COMMENTS: Dear Kelly: Please give this to Eric . I will call you sometime this week to follow-up. Thanks.

Eric: We need you help again, but it is on the same and only issue we talked to you about last May. Based on our discussion of this problem when we met in May, we are confident that you will agree that the former political prisoners have suffered enough. This policy of excluding the over-21 unmarried children has accomplished nothing except to break-up the families in a way that complicates their resettlement in the U.S. and undermines the tradition of family unity that was the cornerstone of the HO subprogram from the beginning (please see attached agreement). The entire Vietnamese community throughout the U.S. is distraught over this issue and prays for your help in resolving the problem. Warm regards. Khuc Minh Tho.

**OVERVIEW OF FAMILY ELIGIBILITY
IN THE PROCESSING OF
THE FORMER POLITICAL PRISONERS
BY THE HO SUBPROGRAM
OF THE ORDERLY DEPARTURE PROGRAM (ODP)**

- 0 On July 29, 1989, Mr. Robert Funseth, Senior Deputy Assistant Secretary of State and representative for the government of the United States, signed an agreement on the Implementation of the Special Released Reeducation Center Detainees Resettlement Program (see attached). This agreement provided for the resettlement of the political prisoners and their "close family members."
- 0 When the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) began the "HO" subprogram of ODP to resettle former political prisoners and their family members, the eligibility criteria for family members stipulated all sons and daughters, including those who were married and their own children (thus, grandchildren of the former political prisoners).
- 0 In 1991, ODP decided to adjust the family eligibility to exclude the married sons and daughters of the former political prisoners. This change was done following consultations among the Bureau for Refugees at the U.S. State Department, the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) at the Justice Department, and advance notice to interested private groups (including the Families of Vietnamese Political Prisoners Association) and ODP. With this advance notice, the Vietnamese community was able to understand and to adjust to the changes of the family criteria.
- 0 In December of 1994, ODP, at a working group meeting with the SRV, announced that effective January 1, 1995, ODP would exclude from family eligibility criteria the over-21 unmarried sons and daughters of the former prisoners from the cases. This change was done without any prior consultations with private interest groups or representatives of the Vietnamese-American community. After protest from the Vietnamese-American community, the management of the Bureau for Population, Refugees and Migration (PRM) at the State Department and INS agreed to allow exceptions for humanitarian reasons, but ODP inconsistently implemented this policy in the field.
- 0 We strongly feel that this last family eligibility change so late in the program is unfair and unacceptable. Those who have been involved with the HO subprogram of ODP from the beginning understand that this is a unique program for the long-suffering former political prisoners. To break-up the families who have waited years for resettlement due to reasons of "fraud control" and "consistency with world-wide immigration practices" is to deny many former political prisoners the chance to resettle in the U.S. as a family, which was the intent of the program from the beginning. It is our experience that resettlement of the former political prisoners with their children as a unit is the best foundation for successful adjustment and integration into the American community, which is built upon the ethos of family values.
