Thỏa Hiệp ký kết ngày 30-7-89 giữa Chính Phủ Mỹ và Chính Phủ Việt Nam cho phép trên 3000 ^{đầu tiên} cứu tử nhân cải tạo và gia đình của họ sang định cư tại Hoa Kỳ trong chương trình ODP đã và đang thực hiện. Chiều ngày thứ sáu 15-12-89, Bà Khúc Minh Tho Hội Trưởng Hội Gia Đình Cứu Tử Nhân Chính Trị VN. và Ông Robert L. Funseth Phụ Tá đặc trách Tỵ Nạn cho Ngoại Trưởng Hoa Kỳ đã thông báo cho ông Trưởng Khanh Tạo, Giám Đốc Trung Tâm Tỵ Nạn và Trưởng Ban Đón Tiếp cứu Tử Nhân Chính Trị Công Sản VN. tại Oklahoma biết là Cứu Tử Nhân Cải Tạo đầu tiên sang định cư tại Hoa Kỳ sẽ đến Okla. City ngày 16-12-89.

Được tin này Ông Trưởng Khanh Tạo liên liên lạc với Văn Phòng Hội Thiện Nguyên Church Wourld Services để biết rõ chi tiết đồng thời báo cho ông Chủ Tịch Ban Điều Hợp Cộng Đồng VN OKLa. để mời đồng bào VN. ra phi trường đón tiếp và yểm trợ.

Người Cứu Tử Nhân Chính Trị đầu tiên đến Mỹ này là Mục-Sứ Lê Thiện Dũng, 40 tuổi, sinh trưởng tại Đà Nẵng, cũng đi với vợ và 2 con, một trai 6 tuổi và một gái 8 tuổi.

Mục Sứ Dũng bị bắt tử tháng 4-1984 về tội tuyên truyền phản cách mạng trong khi ông đang diễn giảng tại Hội Thánh Tin Lành An-Đông, Saigon. Việt Cộng đã kết án ông 5 năm tù khổ sai và đã giam ông tại các trại tù Chi Hòa, trại tù Phạm Đăng Lưu thuộc tỉnh Bình Thạnh và đưa ông lao động tại Sông Bé. Sau 5 năm tù, nhiều gian lao cực khổ Mục Sứ Dũng được phong thích vào tháng 4-1989.

Nhờ sự can thiệp của chính phủ Hoa Kỳ và Giáo Hội Tin Lành Mục Sứ Dũng và gia đình đã đến Okla. City, trong lúc mùa tuyết đang rơi, 10 giờ đêm 16-12-89 trên chuyến bay số 912 của Hãng Delta Air Lines.

Ra đón tiếp tại phi trường Will Roger Okla. City, có khoảng 40 người vừa VN. vừa Mỹ trong số đó có ông Tư Văn Bê Chủ Tịch Ban Điều Hợp Cộng Đồng Lâm Thới Oklahoma, Ông Trưởng Khanh Tạo, Trưởng Ban Đón Tiếp Cứu Tử Nhân Chính Trị Công Sản VN của Cộng Đồng VN OK. Ông Bà BS. Vũ Văn Dzi đại diện OK. Việt Báo, Mục Sứ Lê Quyền, Mục Sứ và Bà David Warren, Mục Sứ Dun Kuncan, Mục Sứ Kirk Goss và đặc biệt Bà Kitty Allen cùng chồng và các con đại diện cho nhà thờ Trinity Baptist tại Yukon, nhà thờ bảo trợ cho gia đình Mục Sứ Dũng. Bà Allen đã sốt sắng lo liệu thu xếp cho gia đình Mục Sứ Dũng rất chu đáo.

Mục Sư Lê Thiên Dung và gia đình đã hết sức cảm động về sự ăn
căn đôn tiếp, thăm hỏi của đồng bào Việt Nam và sự giúp đỡ tận tình của
Hội Thanh. Qua lời phát biểu cảm tưởng Mục Sư Dung đã run run xúc
động bày tỏ lòng tri ân của ông và gia đình đối với đồng bào VN.
và Hội Thanh Bảo Trợ, đã dành cho gia đình ông sự giúp đỡ tận tình và
cảm tình nồng hậu. Ông còn cho biết sau ông sẽ có thêm một số mục sư
và cựu tù nhân chính trị cộng sản VN. sang Mỹ.

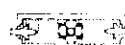
