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Abortion:

... "I arose following a happy time ~~of~~ for my parents. My mother's uterus had such convenient conditions for my development that I thought my parents ^{were} ~~was~~ ^{pleasantly} ~~pleasuring~~ in looking forward to my ~~parents~~ presence".

I was gradually developing and was interested in waiting for the first day of opening my eyes to see the sunlight and coming into the happy life of a baby. It was full of happiness and love ^{from} ~~of~~ parents...

Unfortunately, my expectations did not occur because my parents disliked me in their life. I was already a germ. Why could I not become a human being? Was this termination of my intrauterine life called mercilessness?

Have the women who had the happiness to become the mother-to-be but not desire their unplanned pregnancy ever imagined the lament of their child being born?

In the U.S. the ^{voluntary} ~~induced~~ abortion first became legal in 1973 and can be ^{performed} ~~induced~~ up to ^{the time of} 20 weeks of gestation. Therapeutic abortions are those induced for the purpose of safeguarding in the health of the mother and in cases of genetic diseases and

abnormalities in the fetus or in cases of pregnancy prophylaxis in rape victims that failed.

But gradually, the abortions ^{became} ~~are~~ ~~abused~~ in order to terminate the unwanted pregnancies.

It's difficult to state briefly my own point of view about the support or protest against the abortion because of its relative characteristics. To review this problem, we should have the view of many sides, according to moral, religious, sociocultural, scientific conceptions.

Medically, a fetus less than 20 weeks is unable to survive

extrauterine. Therefore if it affects

either the physical or ^{psychological} ~~psychical~~ health of the mother, it is reasonable

for therapeutic abortion. Also it

in cases of genetic diseases and

anomalies in the fetus because

there is no life at all that

would have been preferable to

life with a congenital defect.

It will be the bad thing for the

psycho-physical development of that

child and for his/her family. In such cases, the induced abortion may be accepted.

In my country or ~~in~~ sociocultural background ~~there~~ are unacceptable the non marital or premarital ~~or~~ pregnancy. ^{It} ~~there~~ is wickedness, so that, it must be terminated. If there is ~~no~~ ^{no} legal abortion, these pregnant women would seek ~~for~~ abortion furtively, which is performed improperly, unsterily and then, it leads to many complications threatening the safety of pregnant women.

However, giving ~~x~~ birth is the initial responsibility of the parents and they also give the child a nurturance including rearing and education until their maturity ~~so that~~ ^{when} they are able to ~~have a~~ ^{live} life independently.

In the undeveloped countries, there are a lot of poor families. They have no convenient conditions to give ~~x~~ birth and raise a child properly, so that they have to seek abortion. This allegation may be relatively accepted. But, in the U.S. there are many agencies which help the children of the ~~low~~ ^{low} income families so that allegation ~~may~~ ^{is} not be reasonable.

For me, ^{opinion} most of ^{people} persons who seek for abortion except therapeutic abortion, make me feel that they are irresponsible. They seem to enjoy themselves and to be displeased at the presence of their child because of the interference of their freedom.
