BOARD MEETING AND ELECTIONS

The meeting for the election of the Board of directors and the Executive Boards was held at the office of the Families of vietnamese Political Prisoners Association (FVPPA) on the above date. The following members were present:

Khuc Minh Tho
Nguyen Quynh Giao
Nguyen Van Gioi
Nguyen Xuan Lan
Nguyen Thi Hanh
Trinh Ngoc Dung
Tran Kim Dung
Truong Thi Lang Anh
Nguyen Thi Khen

Mrs Hiep Lowman and Nguyen Van Gioi were physically unable to be present, however, it was the consent of the Association that their votes, and suggestions be accepted.

In opening the meeting, the President, Khuc Minh Tho, reported on some of the activities of which the Association accomplished during 1992. For example:

- . consolidated the departure program for ex-political prisoners in 1992.
- . simplified and expedited departure procedures for ex-political prisoners
- . increased the number of families of ex-political prisoners arriving in the United States.

- . Intervened with Congress and the State Department for the refugees, former political prisoners and their families who escaped by boat to Southeast Asian refugee camps in the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, and Hong Kong, in order to help them obtain admission to the United States to other third world countries in the free world.
- . intervened with the State Department and ODP regarding simplifying the resettlement process for Vietnamese political prisoners.
- . Requested that the State Department give priority of interview to longest held prisoners of war.
- . Requested Congress and the Department of State to approve the resettlement of the families of political prisoners who died in camps.
- . Requested Congress and the Department of State to increase the budget and the quota for political prisoners during 1993-94.
- . Requested Congress and the Department of State to intervene with Vietnam to release all prisoners by the Vietnamese New Year (February 4, 1992).
- . Requested that the United States government lift resettlement deadlines for ex-political prisoners who have fulfilled all required conditions.
- . Requested that the waiting period for processing for resettlement in the United States be reduced to two years.
- . Intervened with the Department of State that English training for political prisoners free cases be dropped.
- . Organize a National Special Freedom Reunion for former political prisoners in July 1993.

Khuc Minh Tho presented all the details of the situation in all the camps in southeast Asia. She presented detailed information regarding the physical, mental and emotional conditions of political prisoners and the effects of the repatriation program on all refugees in the camps.

Truong Thi Lang Anh, Treasurer, reported on the financial status of the Association throughout the past year (1992). The report indicated that the Association now has in its account \$300.00. According to the treasurer, the Association still needs more financial assistance for its ongoing business expenses such as postage, supplies, printing, utilities and telephone/fax services.

After the President, Treasurer, Advisor in charge of former Vietnamese political prisoners completed their reports, the board of Directors and the Executive Board members all resigned their offices.

Khuc Minh Tho opened the meeting for discussion and voting on new officers. It was felt, that given the status of many negotiations currently underway and in order to provide the continuity that is so vital to these contacts and negotiations, it was the opinion of those present, that the Board of Directors and the Executive Board members be reappointed to another term. This decision was unanimous.



Paris II, USA (Ret.) stated that they are delighted to be serving as volunteer assistants to the President, Khuc Minh Tho. Col. Williams F. Paris will volunteer as Employment Coordinator for former political prisoners. He will serve as the liaison person with companies and different employment offices to assist all former political prisoners in their job search. As a group, all volunteers will work to provide information to the President on issues to be addressed, meetings and presentations requiring attendance and apprising her of other interests of the Vietnamese communities.

- Requested that the United States government lift resettlement deadlines for ex-political prisoners who have fulfilled all required conditions.
- Requested that the waiting period for processing for resettlement in the United States be limited to two years. ^{BNG 2}

Nguyen Van Gioi, Secretary General of the Association, reported the details of the liaison activities with the Department of State, Bureau for Refugee Programs, Congress and the Orderly Departure Office, on behalf of the former and current prisoners in Vietnam to help their release and obtain admission to the United States or other countries in the Free World.

Khuc Minh Tho presented all the details of the situation in all the camps in Southeast Asia. She presented detailed information regarding the physical, mental and emotional conditions of the political prisoners and the effects of the repatriation program on all refugees in the camps.

Truong Thi Lang Anh, Treasurer, reported on the financial status of the Association throughout the past year (1992). The report indicated that the Association now has in its account \$500. ^{300.00} According to the treasurer, the Association still needs more financial assistance for its ongoing business expenses such as

postage, supplies, printing, utilities and telephone/fax services.

After the President, ^{Treasurer} ~~Secretary General~~, Advisor in charge of Former Vietnamese Political Prisoners completed their reports, the Board of Directors and the Executive Board members all resigned their offices.

Khuc Minh Tho opened the meeting for discussion and voting on new officers. It was felt, that given the status of many negotiations currently underway and in order to provide the continuity that is so vital to these contacts and negotiations, it was the opinion of those present, that the Board of Directors and the Executive Board members be reappointed to another term. This decision was unanimous.

Mrs. Thanh Hai Reyes, Mr. Pham Thanh Long, and Nathasia Truong stated that they are delighted to be serving as volunteer assistants to the President, Khuc Minh Tho. They will work to provide information to the President on issues to be addressed, meetings and presentations requiring attendance and apprising her of other interests of the Vietnamese communities.

After discussion of the issues, those persons present voted on the new Board of Directors and Executive Board. Those persons re-elected and their positions are as follows:
