Board Meeting and Elections

The meeting for the election of the Board of Directors and the Executive Board was held at the office of the Families of Vietnamese Political Prisoners Association (FVPPA) on the above date. The following members were present:

Khuc Minh Tho
Nguyen Quynh Giao
Nguyen Xuan Lan

In opening the meeting, the President, Khuc Minh Tho, reported on some of the activities of which the Association accomplished during 1994. For example:

- o consolidated the departure program for ex-political prisoners in 1994;
- o simplified and expedited departure procedures for ex-political prisoners;
- o increased the number of families of ex-political prisoners arriving in the US;
- o intervened with Congress and the State Department for the refugees, former political prisoners and their families who escaped by boat to Southeast Asian refugee camps in the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, and Hong Kong, in order to help them obtain admissions to the United States or to other Third World countries in the free world;

- o intervened with the State Department and the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) regarding simplifying the resettlement process for Vietnamese political prisoners;
- o requested that the State Department give priority of interview to the group of "longest held prisoners of war";
- o requested Congress and the Department of State to approve the resettlement of the families of political prisoners who died in camps;
- o requested Congress and the Department of State to increase the budget and the quota for political prisoners in Fiscal Year 1995;
- o requested Congress and the Department of State to intervene with Viet Nam to release all remaining prisoners, and those re-incarcerated;
- o requested that the United States Government lift resettlement deadlines for ex-political prisoners who have fulfilled all required conditions;
- o requested that the waiting period for processing for resettlement in the United States be reduced to two years;
- o organized a National Special Freedom Reunion for former political prisoners in July 1994;
- o organized a Memorial Celebration to salute the 58,000 Americans who sacrificed their lives for the freedom of Viet Nam;
- o Visited prisoners' families resettled in Houston and Oklahoma during the Thanksgiving Holiday. These families are experiencing hardships due to the lack of employment opportunities in the locality.

Khuc Minh Tho presented all the details of the situation in all the camps in Southeast Asia. She presented detailed information regarding the physical, mental and emotional conditions of political prisoners and the effects of the repatriation program on all refugees in the camps.

Khuc Minh Tho presented that the Immigration and Naturalization Services (INS) and the ODP had denied many applications for admission despite these having fulfilled all admissions' requirements. Reasons for denials included:

- o lack of original copy of certified release from prisoners' camps document;
- o children of decased incarcerated individual or deceased spouse as not eligible for resettlement;
- o non-acknowledgment of marriage certificate of incarcerated individual and/or spouse.

Truong Thi Lang Anh, Treasurer, reported on the financial status of the Association for 1994. The report indicated that the Association now has in its account \$100.00. According to the Treasurer, the Association needs financial assistance for its ongoing business expenses such as postage, supplies, printing, utilities and telephone/fax services.

After the President, Treasurer, and the Advisor completed their reports, the Board of Directors, and the Executive Board members resigned all their offices.

Khuc Minh Tho opened the meeting for discussion and voting of new officers. It was felt, that given the status of many negotiations currently underway, and in order to provide the continuity that is so vital to these contacts and negotiations, it was the opinion of those present that the Board of Directors and the Executive Board members be re-appointed to another term. This decision was reached unanimously.

Mrs. Thanh Hai Reyes, Mr. Pham Thanh Long, and Col. William F. Paris II, USA (Ret.) were then

invited to join the meeting. They expressed their willingness to serve as volunteers for the Association. Col. William Paris II will volunteer as Employment Coordinator. As such, the Colonel will assist former political prisoners in their job search by contacting companies, employment offices and industries for job leads.

The volunteers will assist the President of the Association in providing and dissemination of information on issues of concerns to the Association members, and the political prisoners community-at-large. This would entail attending meetings and/or making presentations (if applicable) at the request of the President.


