You may not believe this but July 1992 will soon be here. It seems to me that just last week was the first week of June 1991. I just don't know where the summer went. Yesterday it was May, tomorrow it is September. While I know it is hard to think of next summer, it will be here before we know it. I keep hearing of all the men who will be in St. Louis but I really need actual numbers. The hotel, the cruise ship, the tour people want commitments. Please guys, commit. We will refund your deposit until the First of July.

Enclosed are a couple of flyers from the hotel and cruise ship and a form to be filled out and returned with your deposit of \$25.00. The form asks for information concerning family and service. Please fill in all parts for those attending. If you are not married but will bring a companion please so indicate and provide their name for Name Tag purposes.

Plans include a River Boat Dinner Cruise (no C-rations) on Thursday evening (firm), a ball game (Friday Evening) if one is available, if not either a tour of the Bud Brewery and a trip to the zoo or Six Flags over Mid America (if no ball game available), a Memorial Service on Saturday morning, followed by business meeting for the members, with a shopping/sight-seeing trip for the families during the meeting, a Dinner dance Saturday night, ending with a Brunch on Sunday morning in the Hotel.

The cost per couple including 3 nights in the hotel, and all activities is \$375.00 until July 1, 1992. After July 1 to July 25, 1992 (Must be in the hands of the undersigned by that date) the price will be \$395.00 per couple. No reservation will be accepted after that date. (The undersigned will have started his travel to St. Louis after that date.) For two (2) individuals sharing the same room the cost will be \$195.00 each until 7/1/92, after that \$215.00 each. Individuals desiring single rooms will have a cost of \$290.00 or \$310 after 7/1/92.

We have set up a plan for payments for anyone who desires. After the \$25.00 deposit has been made, payments of \$50.00 or more may be made until paid in full. Payment in full must reach the undersigned not later than July 15, 1992. Reservations made after July 1, 1992 must be accompanied by payment in full.

USAir has set up a discount for those attending the reunion. The discount is 5% off any already discounted fare that may be available or 45% off regular coach fair. The necessary number for this special fare is on the flyer included with this letter.

We have blocked only 200 rooms for this weekend and all indications are they are going to fill up fast. To increase that number, we must have firm commitments as soon as possible. For

anyone wanting to arrive early or stay late, the hotel will hold the rate for 5 days either side at \$59.00 plus tax for a double room. Make your plans now! Insure yourself a spot at the hotel. Be where the action is!

It is planned to have a special Tee Shirt and Cap made up for this reunion. They will indicate the fact that it is the 1992 Reunion in St. Louis. A separate order blank is included for these items, as only the number which are prepaid will be made up. The order and payment must be received not later than May 30, 1992. The price will be \$10.00 for the ball cap, \$15.00 for the Tee Shirts, both for \$24.00. They will be available upon check in at the Reunion.
