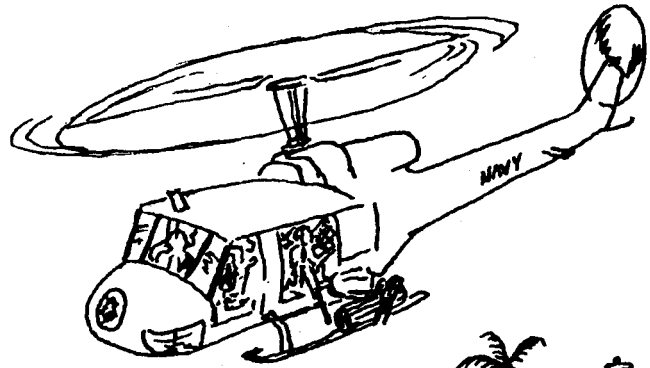
Dear David,
