Dear Mr. Thomson:

Your request for the landing and static display of up to four UH-1 or comparable helicopters on the Marriott Hotel soccer/volleyball field and the departure fly-by is approved for June 12, 13 and 14, 1987, under the following conditions:

1. Because there is no lighting in that field, all aircraft must arrive and depart during daylight.
2. A member of your group, with an Aviation Department representative, will inspect the field for debris and/or obstacles prior to aircraft arrival.
3. The departure fly-by will be as coordinated by your group and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Air Traffic Control (ATC).

All aircraft can expect to enter KCI airspace in accordance with FAA procedures and ATC instructions and will be directed to the landing site. It has been suggested that the aircraft be specifically designated by some pre-assigned call sign; i.e., "Seawolf Flight," "Seawolf Display," etc. Your flight representative should coordinate call signs, arrival times, departure times, and fly-by procedures with the FAA ATC and provide this office with copies of the correspondence. The FAA ATC address is Kansas City International Airport, 2 International Square,
