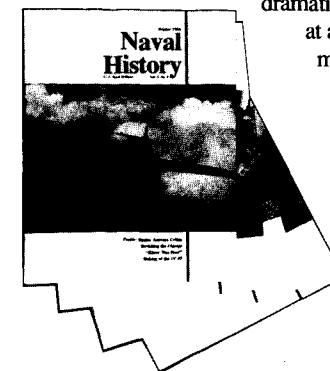
Ship and Aircraft Photos
