THANK YOU FOR FIGHTING AND KEEPING ME FREE AND MOST OF ALL, AMERICA. I KNOW THIS IS LONG OVER DUE, PLEASE ACCEPT MY APOLOGY.

MY HUSBAND, SON AND BROTHER WERE IN OPERATION DESERT STORM. THEY GOT A TREMENDOUS WELCOME WHEN THEY CAME HOME. WELL, I THOUGHT IN MY HEART, HOW WRONG, BECAUSE I WAS HERE WHEN THE GUYS CAME BACK FROM VIETNAM. THERE WAS NO THANK YOU OR NO DESERVED PARADES. I DID SPEAK TO SEVERAL AND TELL THEM, "THIS IS WHAT SHOULD HAVE TAKEN PLACE WHEN THE GUYS CAME HOME FROM VIETNAM, TOO." OF COARSE EVERYONE LOOKED AT ME VERY FUNNY. BUT I DIDN'T REALLY CARE.

WHEN I STARTED WRITING EVERYONE, I NEVER EXPECTED TO EVER GET A LETTER BACK. BUT WHEN I DID, I WAS HONORED. I STARTED THEN MAKING A SCRAP BOOK OF ALL MY LETTERS AND SOME SENT MAPS, PATCHES, PICTURES AND ALL SORTS OF THINGS. THINGS I WILL TREASURE FOR THE REST OF MY LIFE. THEY TOLD ME THINGS THEY DID WHILE ON TOUR, UNITS THEY WERE IN, YEARS THEY WERE THERE, EVERYTHING. I WOULD LOVE TO HEAR YOUR STORY. BUT IF IT IS TOO PAINFUL, I'LL UNDERSTAND.

I'LL GO FOR NOW. AGAIN THANK YOU FOR MY FREEDOM. IF IT HAD NOT BEEN FOR YOU I WOULD NOT BE A FREE PERSON NOW. TAKE CARE. AND MAY GOD BLESS YOU AND YOURS.
