





Let's all get together: three event, show skiers, barefooters, disabled skiers, kneeboard skiers, judges, novice and juniors of all events. There are several rule changes and new rules pending in AWSA right now. I would like to hear from each division at least once a year so I will know how to vote.

The three event Regionals were held in Indiana by the Camalot Ski team. They did a tremendous job and deserve our congratulations. As of now we have NO BID for the 1991 Regionals. Any club interested in hosting the 1991 Regionals should contact me as soon as possible.

AWSA has a membership drive on. I would like to see all members enroll at least one new member. AWSA is only as strong as its membership. Let's all work to increase the total AWSA membership.

I would like to touch on a few of the things going on nationally. A new division for juniors is being considered. The new divisions would break the present division into two categories: from 0-9 inclusive and 10-12, with different starting speeds. This is being looked at with mixed emotions. Our present E.P. system for getting to the National's is also under investigation. Some say we have lost the desire to win a division, only to score a rating. Show skiers now have a strong voice in AWSA, as they pay membership fees and tournament skier fees just like the three event skiers beginning in 1991. A new format for our regional guide is being considered, with the possibility of combining all of the regions into one large tournament guide book.

Locally, Missouri is strong in three-event tournaments. I believe there are some kneeboard tournaments, but I don't know of any barefoot or show tournaments in our state. Please let me know if I am wrong. Our state tournament will again be held in Hartville by John Shull. We all need to thank John for hosting this tournament.

Missouri has always worked hard for novice skiers and this year is no exception. We now have an active club at Lake of the Ozarks that has a novice tournament scheduled for the coming summer. Let's all work to help make it a success. I know the Lake has produced many good skiers and I would like to see a new group of skiers coming out of that area.

I am very proud of our state federation. We continue to grow and improve. Terry Hart and his crew have made a huge commitment to make this newsletter more than just a piece of paper to throw away.

In closing, I want to thank each of you for letting me be your voice in AWSA. I want to stress to you that I want your input on any problems or issues that concern your area of skiing.

Missouri State Junior Development Committee Member - Steve Siu


The summer of 1991 brings to the Missouri Water Ski Federation several new and exciting ideas for tournaments. We hope these changes will include: adding a novice division for new skiers under the age of 17 and splitting the junior novice competitors into two groups. We hope these additions to our tournaments will encourage more youth to take up competitive water skiing and involve more families in our exciting sport.

Past novice tournaments and clinics have introduced a large number of new members, mostly Men I and Men II competitors, to AWSA and MWSF. This is evident at any of our Missouri tournaments by the large numbers of skiers in these age groups and in the novice men division.


Many of these new skiers have said they wish they could have started competitive skiing at a much younger age. Looking at the biography of any pro or national level skier will show that their first taste of competition occurred during their childhood years. No one will deny that it takes years of competitive skiing to reach world class level. Bob and Kris LaPoint, the Mapples and the Duvalls are prime examples. Until now, there has been little concentrated effort in Missouri to bring junior skiers into competitive water skiing.

Recent changes in MWSF tournaments address this youth competition problem. Since there is no AWSA rule for novice competition in the youth division, specific cutoffs for each tournament may vary. The youth may also join AWSA for a \$15 novice clinic membership which will be honored at all MWSF tournaments featuring novice competition. Those who surpass the novice cutoff of a First Class Rating will need to upgrade their AWSA membership to the regular competitive membership. The AWSA novice membership includes a subscription to The Water Skier magazine and the MWSF membership includes this newsletter and t-shirt.

If you know children or youth who water ski, let them know about these new ideas for our tournaments. Help them practice this spring and to prepare for the 1991 tournament season. We would encourage all of our members to make an effort to introduce youth to water skiing. The future growth of water skiing in Missouri lies in fostering the development of our youth, from teaching children to ski, to development of the most talented to an elite level.

National Junior Development

As we look forward to the 1991 ski season we all must remember that the growth of our sport depends upon our youth. The MSWF has always supported the Junior Development programs on the regional level and national levels, but also realizes the need for more activities at the state level.

The Junior Development programs were started to help recognize and improve individual talent among young skiers seventeen years and younger. These programs also help them to prepare for national and world competitions. Waterskiing's future as an Olympic sport is unknown at this time, however, the International Olympic Committee does grant money to AWSA for the development of our junior teams, which does brighten the outlook for us.

For the past five years, there has been a junior team trials to choose young skiers to represent the U.S. in world competitions. This is the ultimate goal for a junior skier (all skiers seventeen years and younger). The team trials this year will be held at Milledgeville, Georgia on July 4-7.

The Regional development program has a team of twelve skiers, six boys and six girls. The team is chosen from the best skiers in the region. These skiers participate in several activities, particularly the ski clinic held in June each year.

On the state level Missouri has several people who have shown interest in getting a program started. Jack Daugherty and John Shull have come up with one incentive for the junior skiers (age twelve and under) for the 1991 season. The youngsters will ski free at all tournaments held at Lake Sundance and Lake Freddie. There will probably be five tournaments including the State Championships at these sites. The only requirement is that they must be a competitive member of AWSA. We hope this will encourage more junior boys and girls to compete next summer. Their skill level is not a factor at all. Just let them come, ski and learn what fun competition can be.
