- This crewman was killed outright by enemy gunfire. His body was never recovered.

- While on a mission into North Vietnam, this crewman was killed outright by enemy gunfire.

19 JUL 67 LT Dennis William PETERSON, 28 (Huntington Park), Pilot 1310
