Dear Tom,

Below is the three additional Seawolf KIA's that I have found in the squadron diaries. I'm afraid that there may be more. I just don't understand why they weren't on the list with the other 41. The list that we got from Gamewardens was taken from the list used to make up The Wall. I used the wall directory and codes to get the cause of deaths and home towns on our KIA's that I sent you. I will track these three names and see if I can find them in The Wall's directory. I'll let you know what I find out.

15 SEP 1969

Seawolf 302, Det Eight, crashed on takeoff from the USS Harnett County. AT 3 Stephen A. Johnson, USN, 883 06 42 and ATN1 Robert J. Arnold, USN, 696 83 45, were killed in the accident.

14 DEC 1969

Seawolf 313, Det Two, crashed on a low level reconnaissance mission. AMS1 Larry.R. Johnson, USN, 540 22 96 was killed in this operational accident.

(Tom, if you recall Det Two was located at Nah Be, 16 miles S.E. of Saigon working the Rung Sat Special Zone).
