



I was a Seawolf from July, 1967 to July, 1968. I started and ended my tour at Det 2-Nha Be, with side trips to Det 3-Vinh Long for a couple of weeks and Det 7-Binh Thuy for a couple of months (including Tet). I have some stuff that I would be willing to loan to you for research or donate to a Seawolf Museum. This stuff includes: Wolfgrams from October, November, December 1967 and April, May 1968; about a hundred photos (black and white and color); some citations, including one with diagram of VC ambush of Seal insertion and Seawolf response; and original black beret with hand sewn TF-116 patch and Thailand Navy hat. I also have a booklet put out by U.S. Naval Support Activity, Saigon, publication date unknown, **THE U.S. NAVY IN VIETNAM** and, **WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT VIETNAM** published by the Associated Press in 1968. Let me know if you are interested in any of this.

In any case please send me a couple of those plastic cups. I understand they are a dollar each but nothing was mentioned about shipping/handling so I'll make the check for three bucks.
