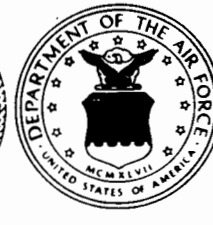

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this book is to provide the reader with information on how to locate present or former members of the military. This includes members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, the Reserve Components, retired members and former members. Whatever the reason for your search, this book provides the best methods to locate and contact present and former military members. There are alternative methods that can be used, so it is recommended that you read the entire book before beginning.

This book is not designed to find people who have changed their identities and do not want to be found, but ones who have moved or you have lost contact with. There is information regarding debt collection and child support collection that may be helpful.

A portion of this book concerns military reunions and veterans organizations. This information is intended to help locate former comrades and to find out about unit reunions. Of special note, many members of one service often join another, the reserves or National Guard. The last component they are or were in has their military records. If you are not sure which service or component the person is in, you must check with all of them.

The author has over 27 years of military service, ten of which were involved with personnel accounting, postal and locator service for active and reserve members of the Army.

This book is the only one available that contains this detailed information for this specialized subject. It reflects many years of research and experience that will save you time and expense. Of far greater importance, you will find the person you are trying to locate.

Coast Guard enlisted rating badges are the same as the Navy's for grades E-1 through E-6, E-7s through E-9s have silver specialty marks, eagles and stars, and gold chevrons. The badge of the Master Chief Petty Officer of the Coast Guard has a gold chevron and specialty mark, a silver eagle and gold stars. Coast Guard officers use the same rank insignia as Navy officers. For all ranks, the gold Coast Guard shield on the uniform sleeve replaces the Navy star.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

The Social Security number, SSN as it is commonly abbreviated is the most important item other than the individuals name you are trying to locate. Every member of the military, active, reserve, National Guard or retired is identified and listed by his SSN. The same is true for veterans though they may also be located by their claim number or their former service number (military service numbers were eliminated by 1974).

It will speed your search to know the SSN of the person who you are seeking. If you do not know it, the government will not tell you what it is. The Privacy Act of 1974 prohibits giving out this information.

There are several ways you may find a SSN. It is contained on military orders, discharges (DD 214), appointments, and in the Register of Officers published by each military service prior to 1976. Many bank statements contain it as well as some driver's licenses. If you have cancelled checks from the individual they may list their SSN. Correspondence from military members usually have their SSN on the return address. You can look at old investments such as money market funds, mutual funds and stock records for a SSN. Most department stores ask for a persons SSN when charge accounts are opened. You might get it from schools or places of employment as a civilian. The military will not give this information to the public.

You may need this number to have your letters forwarded by the military, Social Security Administration, or the Veterans Administration. You may also be asked for their SSN when you call an installation locator, especially if there is more than one person with the same name. Many times individuals are listed by their SSN because it is easier and quicker to find a number on computer records rather than trying to find the person by name.

If you do not have the person's SSN, do not let this stop your search. You may still locate or contact a present or former military member without their SSN if you have one of the following:

- a. Their name and date of birth.
- b. Their name and VA Claim or File number.
- c. Their name and former service number.
- d. Their name and former unit or ship assignment.
(with approximate date assigned)
- e. Their name and a former address.
- f. Their name only in some cases.

Read each section of the book carefully for details.

These prefixes indicate the state in which the Social Security Number was issued. This will assist you in identifying the state where the individual was possibly born or lived in at some time.

TO LOCATE ALL CATEGORIES OF THE MILITARY

The military will either forward a letter or provide you with the current military unit of assignment for the person you are looking for. The latter may be limited to assignments in the United States.

If you want to have a letter forwarded, place the letter in a sealed, stamped envelope. Put your name and return address in the upper left hand corner. In the center of the envelope put the rank, full name of the service member, followed by his Social Security number.

On a separate sheet of paper put everything you know that may help to identify him by the military locator such as:

- Name - rank
- Social Security Number or Service Number
- Military service i.e. Active Air Force
- Date of Birth (estimated if actual is unknown)
- Date of retirement (if retired)
- Sex
- Officer or enlisted (if you do not know
or not sure of his/her rank)
- Date entered service
- Last assignment (if known)

In another envelope, preferably legal size, enclose the letter you want forwarded along with the fact sheet and enclose a check for the search fee.* If you are active or retired military, state it on the fact sheet showing your rank and SSN, and you do not need to send the search fee. On the outer envelope include your name and return address. Address it to the appropriate location below. If they can locate the individual in their files they will forward your letter. It is up to the individual to reply to your letter. The military will not make them reply in this process. If the military locator cannot find the person you are seeking, they will return your letter and tell you why. Common problems include: they cannot identify the individual without a SSN and the name is not unique, the individual has been separated from the service, the SSN is incorrect or the individual is deceased.

To find what unit and military installation a person is assigned to, you can write a letter to the appropriate address below and include as much information as possible that will assist them in identifying the person (include the same information as shown above).

Mail your letter to the appropriate address below. If you know the installation you can call direct to that installation's assistance operator or the installation locator (see instructions under "Base/Post Locator Service"). You can also mail a letter to the individual in care of the Locator of the installation (see list of locators for proper mailing address).

*The search fee required to forward a letter or to find the unit of assignment from the addresses listed in this section is currently \$3.50. There is no fee for forwarding letters through base and post locators.

* The National Personnel Records Center will forward correspondence to the last known address only in limited situations. These include:

- a. Requestor's VA/Social Security benefits are dependent on contacting the veteran.
- b. Veteran to be contacted will have veterans benefits affected.
- c. Forwarding is in veteran's/next of kin's interest; i.e. estate settlement.
- d. Financial Institutions legitimate effort to collect a debt.

The search fee of \$3.50 is applicable only when the forwarding is not in the veteran's interest, i.e. debt collection.

The National Personnel Records Center will place the letter to be forwarded in another envelope and will add the individual's name and last known address. This envelope will not have a return address. In the event the letter is not delivered it will be sent to one of the dead letter offices of the Post Office. They will open the envelope and return the letter to you if you included a return address. (The envelope provided by NPRC may also be returned and you will now know the last known address of the person you are seeking.) You now can use some of the other methods discussed in this book such as placing an advertisement in the newspaper in the city where the person lived, checking city directories or by contacting former neighbors, etc.

If a person writes to the NPRC for assistance locating a veteran and the reason does not fall into any of the above categories, then the writer will be informed to contact the nearest regional VA Regional Office (for requests of fewer than five names) or the VA Records Processing Center (for requests of five or more names). Requests should have the name, SSN, service number or VA claim number.

In July, 1973 a fire at the NPRC destroyed about 80% of the records for Army personnel discharged between November 1, 1912 and January 1, 1960. About 75% of the records for Air Force personnel with surnames from Hubbard through "Z" that were discharged between September 25, 1947 and January 1, 1964 were destroyed. Some alternate information may be obtained from records of the State Adjutants General and State "Veterans Service" offices. Their are currently 48 million records at the NPRC.

BASE/POST LOCATOR SERVICE

The Armed Services has locator services at most of their installations. The Freedom of Information Act provides that the services may release a military members unit or ship assignment. They may provide their duty telephone number, but will not give out their SSN or home address, except when the individual has authorized the release of this information. You may need to provide SSN if there is more than one person with the same name. You can call the locator if you know the installation where the person you are trying to locate or contact is assigned. Locators normally operate during normal duty hours, usually 7:00 or 7:30 am to 4:00 or 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. This service is normally provided by a separate office, especially at larger bases, and sometimes it is provided by the Telephone Information Operator or by the Staff Duty Officer - usually after normal working hours and holidays. When you call, give the name and rank of the person you are looking for and ask for their duty assignment and work telephone number. Many enlisted people live in barracks, dormitories, or quarters on the base as do many single NCO and Officers. They can be contacted through the Charge of Quarters of their unit. Some married NCO and Officers live on base in quarters and they usually have telephone numbers that are available through the local telephone company. Call the local civilian information operator to see if they are listed.

To obtain the telephone number of an installation locator not listed below, you can call the installation information operator who will give you the number. If you know the unit of the person you are trying to reach, the operator can give you that telephone number. You may also write to the locator to obtain the number. Locators keep forwarding addresses for all personnel who are separated from the service or have been transferred for six months after they depart.

Mail for personnel who were assigned to decommissioned ships or installations that are closed will be forwarded for sixty days after closing or decommissioning.

PATERNITY SUITS, CHILD SUPPORT & OVERSEAS MARRIAGES

For any of these matters write to the Commanding Officer of the unit to which the individual is assigned (active duty only). Be sure to include full name, rank, SSN and organization, if known.

The Federal government operates a Parent Locator to help find a person who is delinquent in payment of child support. This locator system is operated in cooperation with various state governments. A person seeking information should contact his/her local child support office or the State Attorney General's office. They will be able to give the present address of any individual who is delinquent in child support, if they have received any federal payments or payments from the Internal Revenue. This service is usually free.

* * *

AMERICAN RED CROSS

The American Red Cross has a special arrangement with the Armed Forces and usually has one or more representatives at each military installation.

To locate a member of the Armed Forces (who is on active duty or active duty for training) due to an emergency in their family at home, such as a death or serious illness, do not contact the military but call your local Red Cross office, they are listed in the telephone book. Tell them the nature of the emergency and the name, rank, and service of the military member. They will immediately investigate the matter, get a message to the military member and make arrangements for his immediate return home, if warranted. They have certain guidelines and if these conditions are met, this is the fastest and best way to get word to someone in the military when a crisis at home exists.

* * *

ACTIVE MILITARY OWES YOU MONEY

If the person you are looking for owes you money and is on active duty with any of the Armed Forces, you should find out to what organization he is assigned, then write a letter to the Commanding Officer of his unit. Include all facts concerning the indebtedness, (i.e. amount, date, purchase, loan, the amount and dates he/she has made payments and current amount due, etc).

The military does not look favorably on delinquency or avoidance of payment of legitimate debts by service members. You will receive a reply from the commanding officer who will advise you what payments you may expect. You will most likely receive such a reply within two to three weeks.

Collection Agencies cannot legally write to an individual's Commanding Officer asking for their assistance; however, they can prepare a letter for their client to an individual's Commanding Officer using the client's letterhead and signed by the client requesting assistance. The letter should state that payments be made directly to the collection agency.

* * *

NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES

There are several periodicals devoted to locating missing people that are of value. When seeking military or former military people, we recommend the following weekly newspapers: *Army Times*, *Navy Times*, *Air Force Times* and *Federal Times*. These are the most popular and widely read newspapers of the Armed Services and Civil Service personnel. *Federal Times* is read primarily by present and former Civil Servants, a large portion who are military veterans, retired military and members of the Reserve Components of all military services. These newspapers have locator columns that may help you. Readers include current military members, but also many reserve, National Guard, retired and former members. You will probably get a response to any published assistance you request.

Fees are minimal. *PSN* has a classified advertisement section and subscribers will research local telephone and city directories, if requested. MERCHANT MARINES

The Merchant Marines is a civil organization and refers to the nation's commercial shipping industry. It is not an Armed or Uniformed Service of the United States. Many Merchant Mariners and Officers are members of the Navy, Coast Guard, and Army Reserves. Also graduates of the U S Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, New York are appointed officers in the U S Navy Reserve. You may locate them through the appropriate military reserve. You may also contact the U S Coast Guard who registers all merchant seamen or contact the following:

In January 1988, a federal court decision awarded veteran status to all merchant seamen who served in World War II, so you can attempt to contact members of this group of Merchant Mariners through the Veterans Administration. This status does not qualify them for membership in some Veterans Organizations such as the VFW.

* * *

THE TELEPHONE COMPANY

Contact your local telephone company and ask them if they have copies of telephone books of out of town cities, especially if the local library does not have the one you need.

Keep in mind that the information operator can give you valuable data in addition to telephone numbers. You can get addresses or you can find out if a certain person has a telephone even if it is unlisted.

If you find out the person you are looking for does have an unlisted number, you can call the operator and have her call the person and ask them to contact you. This service is done only in some areas for emergencies or important matters, so inform the operator of it's importance.

It is important to point out that military bases have their own telephone system which are completely independent of the civilian (Bell, GTE, etc.) companies. They have their own information operators and you can use them (see the Locator section for a list of telephone numbers of these operators).

* * *

THE COURT HOUSE AND CITY HALL

Government records such as deeds to property, automobile registration, marriage license, business names, voter registration, professional licenses, tax records, record of trials (civil or criminal) can be a source of information that can give you current addresses and possibly a SSN of people you are searching for.

Military people often buy real estate near the bases where they are stationed. As they move, they usually rent the property and the tax bill is mailed to them. This information is public record. Check both the courthouse and city hall for tax and deed information. This is best achieved by mail or in person. In many areas utility users (water, gas, electricity, cable television) addresses are available, if requested.

Most employees in local government offices can be very helpful especially if you tell them the urgency and reason for your search.

A trip to your local library can help you to identify county and civil jurisdictions as well as their addresses.

* * *

CIVIL SERVICE

Thousands of former (veterans) and retired military are employed by the Federal Civil Service because of their military experience and many receive hiring preference. To determine if a person is employed by the Federal Civil Service you must contact each Federal Agency since there is no central locator service for current Civil Service employees. You may have letters forwarded to retired members of the Civil Service by sending your letters to the following address:

You may locate people who are Civil Service or Non-Appropriated Civilian personnel who are employed at military bases by calling the appropriate base assistance operator and asking for the telephone number of the Civilian Locator. (See Base/Post Locator section for telephone numbers).

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

The Department of Veterans Affairs (formerly the Veterans Administration) will forward a letter for anyone in a similar manner as the Armed Forces. Before attempting to have a letter forwarded it is recommended that you call the VA Regional Office located closest to you. See the list below for toll free telephone numbers. You should tell the VA counselor that you wish to verify that a veteran is listed in their files before you mail any correspondence. Give the individual's full name and service number, social security number or VA file number if known; if you do not have this information the VA can sometimes identify veterans with either their date of birth, city and state that the person entered the service, branch of service, middle name or possibly the name alone, if the person has a unique name. If the individual's name is listed in the files, ask for their VA File Number.

The VA does not have all Veterans listed in their files, only those individuals who have at some time applied for VA benefits, such as educational assistance, disability compensation, pensions, home loans, and VA insurance. Place your correspondence in an unsealed, stamped envelope without your return address. Put the veterans name and VA file number on the front of the envelope. Next prepare a short fact sheet and state on it that you request the VA forward this letter to the veteran. Tell them you were given the VA File Number by their Regional Office. Also include all other pertinent information to insure they can identify him/her. Include name, service number, SSN, date of birth, city and state entered service, etc. Next place this letter and fact sheet in a larger envelope and mail it to the VA Regional Office you spoke with, or where the office instructed you to send it. If they cannot identify the individual, they will return your letter to you. They will also inform you if the letter is undeliverable by the Post Office.

MAILING FROM A ROSTER

The VA Records Processing Center in St. Louis, Missouri is responsible for research of rosters so people can forward letters to large groups of veterans, such as a military unit reunion notification or to several veterans to secure statements to substantiate VA disability claims. There are two ways to use the VA Records Processing Center:

First, you can submit a roster of veterans names and service numbers (see section of Unit or Ship's Rosters), or one of the following if you do not have a service number to help identify the veteran:

- a. Social Security Number
- b. VA File Number
- c. Date of Birth
- d. Place of entry into service (city and state)
- e. Middle Name
- f. Name only (if veteran has a unique name)
- g. Branch of Service

Include a check for \$2.00 for each name to be researched made payable to the Department of Veterans Affairs. The Center will research the names and provide you a list of each name submitted with the following information:

- a. VA File Number
- b. VA folder location (VA Regional Office)
- c. They will indicate if the veteran is deceased and date of death, if known.
- d. If the VA does not have a record they will notify you of this. In this case, it will be because they cannot identify the veteran from the information provided or that the veteran has never applied for benefits.

The VA File Number is sometimes referred to as the VA Claim Number and may be in some cases, the same as the veterans service number or Social Security number.

The list will be returned to you along with instructions on how to have letters forwarded to these veterans. The letters should be submitted with the VA File Number listed along with their name on an unsealed envelope and with sufficient postage to cover mailing costs with no return address. No letters involving debt collections will be forwarded.

The VA cannot assure that the veteran will either receive or respond to this correspondence. If the letter is returned to the VA by the Post Office as undeliverable the inquirer will be notified approximately five weeks after the letter is mailed.

The other way to use this centers service is by sending the letters, rosters and payments together. The center will do the necessary research and forward the letters. This usually takes up to two weeks to complete. Send rosters and payment or rosters, letters and payment to:

SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION

The Social Security Administration will forward some unsealed letters to people whose names are listed in their files for certain humanitarian reasons that will be beneficial to the receiver. These reasons vary from locating missing relatives, medical reasons, locating heirs to estates and assisting people with claims, etc. Letters that are accepted will be forwarded to their employers or directly to the individual if he/she is drawing benefits. This method is not recommended for contacting active duty military members but may be desirable for members of the reserves and National Guard, disabled, retired and older veterans. Include the SSN of the person you wish to contact. If not known, the SSA can identify people with their name, date and place of birth and name of parents, or name and address of last known employer and period in which employment occurred. Contact any SSA office for assistance and information in this regard.

* * *

INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE

The IRS will forward letters to people on their files that they can identify (with Social Security number) for humane reasons. Such cases are:

- a. Urgent or compelling nature, such as a serious illness
- b. Imminent death or death of a close relative
- c. A person seeking a missing relative

A reunion or tracing a family tree does not qualify as a humane purpose. The IRS will not forward letters concerning debts. If a letter is forwarded by the IRS and is undeliverable by the Post Office and returned to the IRS, it will be destroyed and the sender will not be notified.

If an address can be found, the letter will be placed in an IRS envelope and the addressee will be advised that the letter is being forwarded in accordance with current IRS policy. They will not divulge their current address, nor any tax information and the decision to reply is entirely up to the recipient.

* * *

COLLEGES, UNIVERSITIES, AND ALUMNI ASSOCIATIONS

The Family and Educational Rights and Privacy Act allows schools to release "directory information" to the public without the consent of the student. A student may request that all or part of this information be withheld from the public by making a written request to do so. "Directory Information" includes, but is not limited to, student's name, current address, telephone listing, major, date and place of birth, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, previous educational agencies or institutions attended.

Many active duty military personnel attend colleges and universities on or near their military installations. A large number of former members of the military (veterans and retired) attend college after their release from the Armed Forces (most use VA educational benefits). Many Military members may have attended some institute of higher learning prior to entering the service. Colleges and alumni associations try to keep current addresses of former students and most will either provide the address or will forward a letter. Check with college registrars, main and college libraries to obtain addresses and disclosure policies.

TO LOCATE WIDOWS/WIDOWERS OF MILITARY RETIREES

Some addresses of widows/widowers of military personnel who retired from the Armed Forces (Active duty, reserves and National Guard) may be contained in the files of the individual service, if they are receiving survivor's benefits from that particular service. Not all widows/widowers receive these benefits; therefore the address would not be listed. However, if the person is a recipient of these benefits the Privacy Act prohibits releasing this information, but the service may forward a letter as they will for retirees. MILITARY RECORDS OF PRESENT, FORMER AND RETIRED MILITARY MEMBERS

Limited information from personnel records is available to anyone. The information which can be provided under the Freedom of Information Act (some of this information pertains to members on Active Duty or those in the reserves and National Guard) includes: rank/grade; name; duty status; date of rank/grade; service number; dependents (including name, sex and age); gross salary; geographical locations of duty assignments; future assignment (approved); unit or office telephone number; source of commission (officers); military/civilian education level; promotion sequence number; awards and decorations duty status, official photograph and records of court-martial trials (unless classified). The place of birth, date of and location of death, and the place of burial of deceased veterans can also be released. Complete personnel and health records are available to former members or their next of kin. Because of the Privacy Act the general public will not be provided medical information, SSN or present address.

To obtain records or particular information send a copy of Standard Form 180 "Request Pertaining to Military Records" (sample on the next page). Standard Form 180 is available from most veterans organizations or military installations. You can make a photo copy of the form from the one in this book. Include as much information about the veteran as you can. You must state on Standard Form 180 if you are requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act.

There is no charge to former service members or their next of kin; however, others must pay a nominal fee for research and photo copying.

Read and prepare the form carefully and mail to the appropriate address on the form. A reply may take from one to six months. The NPRC receives up to 200,000 letters and requests each month.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Information needed to locate records. Certain identifying information is necessary to determine the location of an individual's record of military service. Please give careful consideration to and answer each item on this form. If you do not have and cannot obtain the information for an item, show "NA," meaning the information is "not available." Include as much of the requested information as you can. This will help us to give you the best possible service.

2. Charges for service. A nominal fee is charged for certain types of service. In most instances service fees cannot be determined in advance. If your request involves a service fee you will be notified as soon as that determination is made.

3. Restrictions on release of information. Information from records of military personnel is released subject to restrictions imposed by the military departments consistent with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act of 1967 (as amended in 1974) and the Privacy Act of 1974. A service person has access to almost any information contained in his own record. The next of kin, if the veteran is deceased, and Federal officers for official purposes, are authorized to receive information from a military service or medical record only as specified in the above cited Acts. Other requesters must have the release authorization, in item 5 of the form, signed by the veteran or, if deceased, by the next of kin. Employers

and others needing proof of military service are expected to accept the information shown on documents issued by the Armed Forces at the time a service person is separated.

4. Location of military personnel records. The various categories of military personnel records are described in the chart below. For each category there is a code number which indicates the address at the bottom of the page to which this request should be sent. For each military service there is a note explaining approximately how long the records are held by the military service before they are transferred to the National Personnel Records Center, St. Louis. Please read these notes carefully and make sure you send your inquiry to the right address. Please note especially that the record is not sent to the National Personnel Records Center as long as the person retains any sort of reserve obligation, whether drilling or non-drilling.

(If the person has two or more periods of service within the same branch, send your request to the office having the record for the last period of service.)

THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE

If you know the former address of the person you are looking for, you may find their current address from the Post Office. Go to any Post Office, but preferably to the one they received their mail from and ask for a "Freedom of Information" request form. Or write a letter and request the address under the Freedom of Information Act (you must include their previous address).

The Post Office will mail you the individual's new address if a change of address has been submitted and it is not over 18 months old (the Post Office forwards mail for 12 months but keeps this information for 18 months). The cost of this service is only \$1.00 and well worth the time and cost involved. If the person has a post office box they will not give you their home address if the box is for personal use, but will give it to law enforcement officials and individuals by court order. If the box is for business use, the post office will give you the name, address and telephone number of the renter.

You may also mail a letter to the person you are seeking at his last known address and if you write on the lower edge of the envelope or below the return address "ADDRESS CORRECTION REQUESTED", the Post Office will send you a copy of the Change of Address Card or a photo copy of your letter with the forwarding address on it and they will return your letter to you. You may also put "DO NOT FORWARD" and the letter will be returned to you and they will provide you with the individual's new address. The 18 month rule applies here also. There is a fee of thirty cents. You might want to use this method when you forward letters through the World Wide Locators, Base Locators, Alumni Associations and Social Security Administration and you may find the persons current address in this manner.

LOCATE BY DRIVER'S LICENSE, MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Most people have a driver's license and own a car. You can obtain their address by contacting the driver's license and/or motor vehicle department of the issuing state. Each charge a fee, usually two to five dollars. Addressees of DMV and Driver's Licence Offices are listed in appendix D & E. Most active duty military personnel usually keep their driver's license and their cars registered in their home state when they are stationed within the United States. When they are transferred overseas they usually must get a new driver's license and vehicle tags issued by the US military or from the country where they are stationed.

THE NATIONWIDE LOCATOR

The Nationwide Locator provides an easy and quick way to locate people whether military or civilian. This organization has access to a computerized data base containing over 110 million names, addresses and telephone numbers. This highly accurate data base is updated continually by using addresses provided by telephone directories from every city in the United States, the National Change of Address files from the US Post Office, all major magazine subscribers, and the State Driver's License Offices.

The Nationwide Locator can provide you with the individual's current address, listed telephone number and the names, addresses and listed telephone numbers of their five closest neighbors. You must provide either:

1. Name and a former address
(street and number, city, state and zip code)
2. The person's Social Security Number.

There is no charge if The Nationwide Locator cannot obtain an address.

THE LIBRARY

Your local library is a place you must spend some time, if recommended means have failed to locate the person you are searching for. The information section of most libraries has telephone books from numerous cities, criss-cross reference books of local areas, directories of national telephone numbers, city directories and much more. If you talk to the librarians and tell them what you are doing, you may get some help and ideas.

The History and Genealogy section have rosters of people who belonged to military and veterans organizations, or you may want to search based upon location, events, etc. The opportunities are endless. The Church of the Later Day Saints (Mormons) has numerous local genealogical libraries with large amounts of information and numerous telephone books.

If you have the opportunity to visit the Library of Congress, there are literally millions of books and reference materials that can be of help to you. Particularly helpful are the registers that individual military services once published that list all Warrant Offices and Officers. They were usually published annually and contain a great deal of information.

Most military installations have base libraries and many have some information about the units that were stationed there. Call the information operator of the base concerned to obtain the telephone number of the base library.

Let me remind you to ask for help from the Library Staff. They can be of great assistance to you in your search.

LOCATING MISSING PEOPLE THROUGH PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS

Some difficult cases may need the help of a professional investigator. There are numerous investigators listed in local telephone books, but before you enter into any agreement, check their references and costs closely. One agency that has an impeccable reputation with outstanding results in handling extremely difficult cases is the Family Search Service. CORRESPONDENCE TO MILITARY AND GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

When you write to any military or federal office seeking addresses or assistance, it is recommended that all correspondence be typed, if possible. They are in receipt of thousands of letters and if your handwriting is hard to read, it will be handled last or perhaps not at all. Make a copy of your letter for your records. If you have not received a reply in a reasonable period of time, write them again and enclose a photo copy of your original letter.

Be sure your letter is clear, business like and to the point. Never use vulgarity or threatening language as this is a sure way to get a negative reply or no reply at all.

If there is a fee required, enclose either a money order or a bank cashiers check to insure more timely service. Most agencies accept personal checks, but some wait for them to clear before they take any action on your request. In your letter, state that a check for "xx" amount is enclosed. A check to most government agencies should be made payable to the: Treasurer of the United States.

The actual letter should show the complete address even though it is also on the envelope. Most mail is opened in a central mail room and many times the envelopes are lost and your letter will go undelivered or delivered to the wrong office.

VETERANS, MILITARY, AND PATRIOTIC ORGANIZATIONS

Veterans, military, and patriotic organizations can be of help in locating veterans and providing information about reunions of former military organizations. The service and assistance varies with each organization. Some have magazines which publish names of veterans that people are trying to locate and dates that military unit reunions are being held.

The addresses and telephone numbers of most of the national organizations are listed here and in Appendix B. When you contact them list as much information as you know such as names, aliases, date of birth, dates of service, rank, service or SSN - (see sample letter following this section). All listed organizations (except the American Legion) will provide locator service and/or will forward letters to present and former members. There are usually no fees required for these services.

UNIT AND SHIP'S ROSTERS:

You can obtain a copy of your unit/ship's roster list of personnel or organizational records by requesting them from the National Personnel Records Center. If the roster is needed to support a VA claim, there is no cost. You may obtain such records at a minimum cost of \$8.30 (deposit) an hour plus a searching cost of \$13.25 per hour if you request records for matters other than VA claims. Reunion requests receive low priority and may take considerably more time to process. You may also make a "Freedom of Information Act Request" for a roster and there is no fee charged. If you are planning a reunion or need the service number of an individual, this is the place to start. The roster will have name, rank and service number (if prior to July 1, 1969 for Army and Air Force, July 1, 1972 for Navy and Marine Corps and October 1, 1974 for Coast Guard) but Social Security Numbers will be removed. Be sure to state in your letter the date of the roster requested e.g., May 1945 and that this is a "Freedom of Information Act Request" (do not mention reunions on this request).

The National Personnel Records Center have copies of the following:

- a. US Army Morning Reports and Personnel Rosters from November 1, 1912 to 1974 and all subsequent reports (including SIDPERS reports) after Morning Reports were discontinued.
- b. US Air Force Morning Reports from September 1947 to June 30, 1966.
- c. US Navy Muster Rolls from 1939 through 1946.

CONGRESSIONAL ASSISTANCE

If you are not getting results or answers from Federal Agencies or the Military, you can write your United States Congressman or Senator and ask for their assistance. The military and other government agencies are very responsive to inquiries from Members of Congress. You can expect a quick reply to your letter, usually within two weeks.

Include all the information you can about the person you are trying to locate, why you need to contact him/her, what steps you have taken so far and the results of these steps. See your local telephone book for your Congressman's address and telephone number. It may help, if you call his office first and talk to the administrative assistant for information.

SOMEONE MAY BE LOOKING FOR YOU!

If you are a veteran there is a good chance that someone you served with or your reunion organization is actively seeking you. If you do not belong to a reunion organization or a veterans organization you should consider joining one. Most organizations have been made up of veterans who have contributed time, money and effort to promote issues that benefit veterans. By becoming a member of an organization you will have made it easier for your unit reunion organizers and others to find you.

2. Residence addresses at time of marriage
3. Ages at time of marriage (or dates of birth)
4. Month, day and year of marriage
5. Place of marriage (city or town, county and state)
6. Purpose of which copy is needed
7. Relationship to person whose record is being requested

The following information is needed to obtain divorce records:

1. Full names of husband and wife (including nicknames)
2. Present residence address
3. Former addresses (as in court records)
4. Ages at time of divorce (or dates of birth)
5. Date of divorce or annulment
6. Place of divorce or annulment
7. Type of final decree
8. Purpose for which copy is needed
9. Relationship to person whose record is being requested

GLOSSARY

ARMED FORCES

Composed of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and the Coast Guard.

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

The Department of Veterans Affairs is the new name for the Veterans Administration. In this book we use both names along with the abbreviation VA.

LOCATOR

An office or organization that has names, SSN, and units of assignment of all military personnel assigned to a particular installation.

MERCHANT MARINES

The civilian Maritime Fleet.

RANK

The grade or rating an individual holds in his military organization.

RETIRED MILITARY MEMBER

A person who has completed twenty or more years of duty in any of the military components is entitled to retired pay. He may be retired from an active or reserve component of a service. A member may be retired from active duty for disability due to injury or illness with less than 20 years of service.

SERVICE NUMBER

A number formerly used by the services to identify individual members. The SSN is now used in place of the service number. The Army and Air Force discontinued using Service Numbers on July 1, 1969, The Navy and Marine Corps on July 1, 1972 and the Coast Guard on October 1, 1974.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

The nine digit number that is used by the Social Security Administration and the various uniformed Services to identify individuals.

THE UNIFORMED SERVICES

Composed of the Armed Forces, the Public Health Service, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

VETERAN

A person who has served on active duty in one or more of the Armed Services.

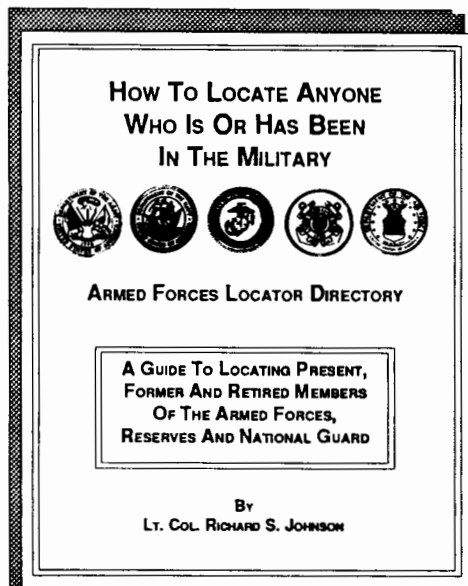
