The objective was the pilot of an Air Force ^{SLIDE} F-105, that ejected approx 80 miles south of HAIPHONG.

The wingmen alerted the ^{SLIDE} HU-16 on orbit who proceeded to the scene. A U.S. Navy helicopter located and recovered the pilot, then delivered him to a Navy destroyer.

The U.S. Navy is claiming 1 combat save. The only time reported was 1 sortie for 30 minutes.
