1. (U) This report is submitted IAW ARRS 55-2/3 ARRGp Sup 1, dated 15 June 1967.
2. (S) Jolly Green 37 and 36 were launched from alert status at NKP, proceeded to a position 103/100/98 and orbited for 3 hours 45 minutes attempting contact of a ground party. No contact was made and JG 36 and 37 were returned to NKP landing at 1530L.
