

OPERATION ORDER

1. SITUATION.

- a. Enemy Forces: Situation, capabilities, indications.
- b. Friendly Forces: Mission and location of higher, adjacent and supporting units.
- c. Attachments and Detachments: Units attached to or detached from your unit by higher headquarters, and effective time.

2. MISSION. State the mission of your unit.

3. EXECUTION.

In first subparagraph give summary of the tactical plan or operational concept.

In succeeding subparagraphs assign missions to each organic and attached unit.

In the next to the last subparagraph designate and assign missions to reserve.

In last subparagraph list coordinating instructions common to two or more subordinate units.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS. Supply, evacuation, transportation, service, personnel and miscellaneous.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL.

- a. Signal instructions and information.
- b. Command posts, location of commander.

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
