1. GIAP ADDRESSES THIRD MILITARY ZONE CADRE.

Radio Hanoi (in Vietnamese 1115 GMT 6 August 1969) reported a conference of cadres called by the Party Committee of the Third Military Zone.

Reporting the attendance of General Giap, the broadcast said:

"General Vo Nguyen Giap intimately talked to the conference. After extending affectionate regards from the Party Central Committee, President Ho, and the Central Military Affairs Party Committee to all cadres and armed forces' combatants as well as compatriots, cadres, and party members in various localities, the comrade dealt with the brilliant successes and the great strength of the people's war in various localities in the socialist North.

"The comrade pointed out our Party's main experiences in the four years of brave resistance against the U.S. imperialists' destructive war in various localities. The comrade analyzed the new developments in our Party's military lines through the tasks of mobilizing all our people to fight the aggressors and oppose the destructive war of their air force and navy, mobilizing our forces in wartime, and building and developing the regional armed forces through the task of providing the economy with new trends, developing the regional economy, and building socialism in wartime in localities.

"The comrade pointed out the increasingly important position of the regional military task within the framework of all our Party's military tasks and stressed the need to satisfactorily recapitulate the experiences acquired in the people's war in the North and to simultaneously endeavor to learn from the valuable experiences of the Southern compatriots and liberation armed forces. The comrade stressed the need to strengthen the regional party chapters' leadership over the regional military tasks, thus making them catch up with the party's undertaking of building the regional economy, with a view to developing the great strength of localities and strongly building the great strength of localities and strongly building them in the economic and national defense fields, thus contributing

toward leading the anti-U.S. national salvation undertaking to final victory, while satisfactorily preparing to build the armed forces and consolidate national defense on a long-range basis and vigorously push forward socialist construction.

"Following this, the comrade set forth a number of main tasks to be firmly grasped in order to vigorously develop the regional military tasks. The conference worked intensively and ended successfully."

2. ALLIANCE'S STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE LE HIEU HO'S APPEAL.

Liberation Radio (in Vietnamese 1400 GMT 5 August 1969) read the statement of Le Hieu Dang, student representative and assistant Secretary-General of the Alliance's Central Committee on President Ho's 20th of July appeal. Extracts follow:

"President Ho's 20 July appeal represents the earnest aspirations of all the Vietnamese armed forces and people and their iron-like determination to defeat the U.S. imperialists and, thereby, compel them to unconditionally withdraw all U.S. and satellite troops from South Viet-Nam. This determined-to-fight-and-win appeal, which is reminiscent of our people's old vow to regain national independence, has resounded countrywide, urging Vietnamese who love their country and fellow-countrymen to vigorously advance under the anti-aggression national banner shinning with the just cause.

"Over the past fifteen years, the southern urbanites, including youths and college and high school students, have lived a grievous life in the tyrannical grip of the U.S. aggressors and their lackeys. In these fifteen years, our southerners should have enjoyed peace and a decent life in an independent and unified Viet-Nam, and our college and high school students should have peacefully pursued their studies so that, one day, they might devote their knowledge and the enthusiasm of youth to rebuilding the country torn by the nine year war. But the U.S. imperialists, nursing the mad ambition to rule the world, brazenly broke their pledge and began to sabotage the Geneva agreements immediately after they had been signed, waging the dirtiest war of aggression in history against the South Vietnamese people and committing towering crimes which have vigorously disturbed the conscience of all mankind.

"More than ever, college and high school students have affirmed their resolute stand vis-a-vis the U.S. aggressors and the Thieu-Ky-Huong clique. With the experiences drawn at the cost of their lives over the past ten years, students are deeply aware that as long as the U.S. aggressors and their lackeys remain in South Viet-Nam, the South Vietnamese people will be deprived of genuine independence and freedom, and that as long as the South Vietnamese people's right to self-determination is not achieved, there will be no genuine peace. There will definitely be no
