"In the medical branch, there is a disease which has been mystically named somnambulism. Those suffering from this disease eat, drink, and walk in broad daylight like normal people. But, in truth, they are somnambulists, unconscious of what happens in the outer world.

"It is learned that in the United States the medical branch, especially the neuropathic science, has developed fairly vigorously, and that this disease has been basically eliminated for more than a year now. But there still is a seriously ailing patient whom the most famous U.S. surgeons cannot cure. This seriously ailing patient is President Nixon, the most powerful man in the United States. The development of Nixon's disease has brought about many complications, thus making his words and acts become increasingly ridiculous, if not to say, stupid.

"By last mid-October, millions of U.S. people, awakening from the U.S. aggressive war in Viet-Nam, scethingly struggled and demanded that Nixon promptly stop sending money and U.S. youths to commit crimes and die shamefully in Viet-Nam. Millions of U.S. people from all walks of life, including U.S. congressmen and high-ranking officials in the U.S. administration, have insulted and cursed him and unanimously demanded that all U.S. troops be promptly brought home.

"Despite this, President Nixon shamelessly pretended to be unconscious of everything. He continues to be absorbed in the illusory dream of Vietnamizing the war, to let unfortunate mothers and young wives meet their sons and husbands placed in coffins, and to harness the lame horses Thieu, Ky, Khiem to the ramshackle aggressive cart. Insults, tomatoes, and rotten eggs in the United States have been insufficient to awaken President Nixon from his dream.

"Recently, in Saigon, the Thieu-Ky-Khiem clique blew bugles to mournfully commemorate the sixth anniversary of its country-selling day, amid resounding insults uttered by the Southern urbanites from all walks of life. Public opinion in various countries held that there was never before such complete unanimity among the people and the Saigon press and congress in vehemently condemning and protesting Thieu, Ky, and Khiem as that achieved by the present movement of protest against the arbitrary tax hike measure. This decision to levy higher taxes on more than 1,500 types of imported goods has caused prices of goods to soar tremendously, thus digging deeper into the purses of the Southern urban consumers.

"Those having money rushed to buy goods and to stock them. Speculators have taken advantage of this opportunity to rule the roost. Workers,

public servants, troops, and officers have been the ones who have been driven to an impasse. Housewives' insults and blows from workers and college and highschool students are being directed from all directions at the den dubbed 'independence' in Saigon. Rumors about a coup d'etat plot have stirred public opinion. Thieu is panic-stricken. He tearfully delivered a speech on the night of 31 October, calling on the robbed people not to hate and reproach him and saying that, otherwise, he would leave for his villas and dollars in foreign countries.

"According to AFP, Thieu is in an extremely precarious situation despite this. Also on 31 October, President Nixon shamelessly sent a congratulatory cable to the Thieu clique, praising its great achievements in improving the Southern people's livelihood and in insuring their happiness and welfare.

"Alas! How ridiculous the President of the United States is. If President Nixon denies that he has suffered from somnambulism in broad daylight, well-informed people will be forced to approve the title which U.S. and Western public opinion awarded him, which is 'Nixon, an impostor'. In line with this logic, anyone who, because of the White House' noisy advertisement, expects something new and uncommon from Nixon's 3 November speech, must be aware that this is pure illusion. Only by vigorously striking at Nixon's nerves or by tumbling the lame horses Thieu, Ky, and Khiem can one awaken him and cure him of somnambulism."
