(C) Items 1 - 2: (3 pages, handwritten and typewritten; B-3) Directive, undated, signed by Trần Ngọc Trác for the Commanding Officer, LBN 6411 Ap Thái, aka Unit 70B ((possibly Political Staff, Quang Đà Special Zone, Military Region 5)), sent to Q.83 Anh Dũng ((possibly Đại Lộc District, Quang Đà Special Zone)), concerns the performance of military and enemy proselyting missions during Christmas and the 1970 New Year's Day.

Document states that after suffering successive defeats, the Americans are being forced to pull out of SVN. They will very slowly withdraw from SVN while implementing their plan for de-Americanization of the war.

The withdrawal of US troops and the worldwide antiwar movement seriously affected the morale of the Americans and their Puppets ((RVNAF)). They expressed antiwar feelings and hope for restoration of peace. Christmas and the 1970 New Year's Day, therefore, are favorable opportunities for friendly ((VC/NVA)) cadre to perform military and enemy proselyting.

Document continues that upon receiving this directive, subordinate units were to prepare immediately for this military proselyting mission. They were to deploy military proselyting personnel and prepare leaflets and posters in English and Vietnamese.
