SUBJ: Resolution on Campaign H25, Current Affairs Committee, VC Quang Nam Province Party Committee, VC Region 5. (U)

(C-Mar 71) (8 pages, typewritten; B-3) Resolution 93/NQ, classified ((VC)) Secret, dated 3 Sep 70, adopted by HK100 ((possibly Current Affairs Committee, VC Quang Nam Province Party Committee, VC Region 5)) at a plenary meeting held on 31 Aug and 1 Sep 70, prescribes activities to be performed by subordinate units and districts during ((Campaign)) H25 as follows:

Guerrilla units were to be developed and guerrilla warfare was to be intensified in every district of the Province to frustrate the enemy pacification plan. Village guerrillas were to coordinate with local force elements to destroy ((RVNAF)) Regional Force companies. Mined areas were to be constructed on the hills which were used by the enemy as landing zones ((for heliborne operations)). Guerrilla units were to perfect their antitank and antiaircraft techniques. Two-thirds of the Party members ((in each village)) were to join the guerrilla ranks, and 100% of the Youth Group members were to take part in guerrilla warfare.

Emphasis was to be placed on military proselyting actions designed to disorganize ((RVN)) Regional and Popular Force units, and to disrupt the People's Self-Defense Force. The population was to be urged to oppose ((RVN)) conscription and to refuse to join People's Self-Defense Force units. Villagers were to be urged to refuse to implement the resettlement plans ordered by the enemy ((GVN)). They were to demand their return to their native land to resume farming activities.

In enemy ((RVN)) controlled villages, one-third to two-thirds of ((VC)) organic cadre were to be employed to return the population to the friendly ((VC)) side and to restore friendly control. In each district, three members of the district's Current Affairs Party Committee were to be designated to supervise friendly activities in the front line areas.
