SUBJ: Efforts to Relieve the Present Famine in Binh Sơn District by the Binh Sơn District Current Affairs Committee, VC Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5. (U)

(C-May 71) (1 page, typewritten; B-3) Directive, dated 1 Nov 70, prepared for the signature of Tân Công for R.021, ((possibly the Binh Sơn District Current Affairs Committee, VC Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5)), forwarded to all subordinate N's, S's, ((possibly agencies and villages)), and 135, ((possibly Binh Sơn District Unit)), states that addressees were to intensify their farm production during the 1970-1971 winter-spring growing season in order to relieve the present famine in the district. Regarding the growing of manioc in such villages as Binh Hoa, Binh Thanh, and Binh Tri, where cultivated areas were recently cleared by the enemy ((FWMAF/RVNAF)), the document directs that Binh Hoa Village be considered an ideal place for growing manioc during this season. The house of Brother Cuc, a former village unit leader of S24 ((possibly Binh Hoa Village Unit)) would be the collection point for ((young)) manioc plants to be distributed to the following ((agencies and villages)) within the period 10 Nov to 10 Dec 70: NB, NN, NC, NO, ND, NP, NR, NQ, NE, NG, NI, NH, NK, NM, NT, S18, S20, S24, S26, and 135.
