SUBJ: VC Indoctrination Material. (U)

(C-Nov 71) (11 pages, typewritten; B-3) Indoctrination material, undated, originated by an unspecified ((VC/NVA)) agency ((in VC Military Region 3)), pertains to the enemy ((FWMAF/RVNAF)) and friendly ((VC/NVA)) situations in Indochina during the past two years ((possibly 1969 and 1970)).

Document states that since the enemy has sustained repeated defeats throughout Indochina, he will carry out the following in the future: (1) Keep an important "residual" US force in SVN to support the Vietnamization program; (2) consolidate the enemy's oppressive machinery in rural areas; (3) strive to consolidate the Puppet Administration at various levels; (4) destroy and root out revolutionary agents and armed forces ((from the rural areas)); and (5) intensify conscription and troop upgrading activities. However, the enemy will be faced with many political and economic difficulties if the US speeds up its Vietnamization program. The Puppet ((RVNAF)) Army may fail to take charge of the military burden in the defense of SVN and Cambodia.

The document calls for all subordinate units and agencies to destroy the enemy oppressive machinery in rural areas and to promote the ((political struggle)) movement in ((RVN)) urban areas. A broad anti-US struggle for national salvation should be initiated in both rural and urban areas. Main force units are to destroy US and Puppet "mobile" units and ((RVNAF)) local force units. Emphasis should be placed on increasing the combat efficiency of sapper, special action, engineer, secret guerrilla, and armed reconnaissance units. The people and ((RVNAF)) soldiers' relatives are to be motivated to carry out military proselyting activities. ((VC)) agents are to be planted in the Puppet Army.
