II. NLF CALLS FOR "COMBAT ACTIVITIES" IN SAIGON

(Liberation Radio, clandestine, in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 1400 GMT 16 Dec. 1970)

On 13 December 1970, the Saigon-Cholon-Gia Dinh People's Revolutionary Committee and NFLSV Committee issued an appeal, calling on the Saigon-Cholon-Gia Dinh compatriots, fighters, and cadres to step up their combat activities to appropriately punish the U.S. aggressors for having committed crimes in the North and murdered student Nguyen Van Minh in Qui Nhon. The appeal exposed the U.S. aggressors' barbarous crimes against our compatriots, while voicing support for the seething struggle which has been staged by the brother and sister college and high school students and the compatriots of all walks of life in Saigon and Qui Nhon, in protest against the bloodthirsty Americans.

The appeal stressed: We earnestly call on the Saigon-Cholon-Gia Dinh compatriots to tighten their ranks, further broaden the united front, and step up the struggle movements to demand that the U.S. aggressors and their satellites indemnify the victimized families, hand the culprits over to the Vietnamese people for trial, end their barbarous crimes against our people, end their aggressive war, promptly withdraw all the U.S. and satellite troops from the southern part of our country, abandon their country-selling, warlike lackeys Thieu, Ky, and Khiem, and respect our national sovereignty and independence.

We call on all the fighters of the Saigon-Cholon-Gia Dinh armed forces to further sharpen their combat determination to continuously attack the enemy, to develop guerrilla warfare, to annihilate a substantial part of the enemy potential and war equipment, to support the uprising movement in gaining mastership at basic levels, and to contribute toward frustrating the U.S. -puppet's Vietnamization-of-the-War plan right in their last den.
