Gayler Saigon Visit

[Text] According to AFP, yesterday morning, 15 February, Admiral Gayler, commander of the U.S. Forces in the Pacific, arrived in Saigon from Phnom Penh as part of his trip to assess the military situation in Indochina. The U.S. Embassy spokesman admitted that Gayler had met with Thieu for an hour before returning to Honolulu.

In addition to the hurried shipments of weapons and aircraft parts for the Saigon administration, the illegal dispatch of more U.S. pilots to South Vietnam and the arrival of U.S. Defense Department and State Department delegations in South Vietnam, Gayler's trip to Saigon to guide Thieu in conducting the war is undeniable evidence of U.S. military involvement in South Vietnam.
