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(C) Resolution to Win the Final Victory by COSVN.
(C) Speech, incomplete, classified ((VC)) absolute Secret, delivered by a high ranking cadre at the end of a four-day meeting ((poss at Region 2 Party Committee)) attended by the key cadre in charge of various main fronts, the delta of Cuu Long River, the mountainous areas, sections and branches subordinate to TWC, to study the new resolutions passed by TW ((poss VN Labor Central Party Committee)) and TWC ((poss COSVN)).

6 Nov 68
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The speaker first assures the audience that presently they ((VC)) have the opportunity and possess the ability to win the final victory in the immediate future and also states that they must win at any cost.

Then the speaker explains the ((NVN)) policy concerning SVN Revolution utilizing dialectical materialism. He also analyzes the basic topics of Resolution #8 passed by TWC and outlines the immediate missions.

The doc states in substance that the SVN Revolution is an inseparable part of an international revolution (staged by the Communist Bloc) whose strategy consists of defeating Imperialism "step by step, one by one ((Imperialist country)), and place by place". This strategy must fulfill two missions: (1) promoting the international revolutionary movement of the working class and oppressed nations, and (2) preservation of the world's peace to check the US Military interventions which tend to consolidate the defense network of the imperialist bloc.

In initiating the SVN Revolution, TW has complied with this policy line. It has decided that SVN should engage in a transitory period of "Independence, Democracy, Peace, and Neutrality" before completing a nationalist and democratic revolution which will lead to the reunification of the whole country and to socialism. That for this reason, TW advocated at the 9th and 11th Congress to defeat the US and their henchmen in SVN boundary. When the VN war turned into a limited war with direct military intervention by the US, the Party committed the forces of both NVN and SVN to pursue a protracted war but also advocated that double efforts should be made to gain the final success on the SVN battleground in a relatively short time. Since spring 1968, the Gen Offensive and Uprising has forced the US to limit their air attacks on NVN and negotiate for peace. "The US will be compelled to halt all bombing and hostilities against NVN and seek for a political solution for the SVN problem in the near future."

The enemy's present "Clear and Hold" strategy is merely a desperate attempt to defend its last sanctuary but is very vulnerable. Therefore, "we presently have the best opportunity to gain the final victory. Consequently, we must strive to win it at any cost in the immediate future.
