SUBJ: (C) Guerrilla Warfare Movement of Phu Cat District Unit, Binh Dinh Province, Military Region 5.

(C) (21 pages, typewritten; B-3) Report, signed by Nguyen Thi Lanh for HB80 ((possibly Phu Cat District Unit, Binh Dinh Province, Military Region 5)), pertains to the development of its guerrilla warfare movement from Oct 68 to May 69.

Document begins with a review of achievements of the district guerrilla warfare movement and states that during the reported period, 175 guerrilla attacks were conducted throughout the district, resulting in 630 enemy (including 14 Americans and 163 South Koreans) put out of action, 15 military vehicles and seven bridges destroyed, and two aircraft downed. The district guerrillas also successfully induced 518 ((RVNAF)) troops to desert, promoted 16 mass uprisings (which rallied more than 10,344 people), and increased the building of combat villages.

Cat Hanh was considered to be a leading village with its very effective defensive networks.

During the reported period, 249 youths were recruited to replenish the district's guerrilla forces, but this number met only 6% of the prescribed recruitment requirements. In addition, the document states that the district's guerrilla warfare movement was still too weak and that the majority of the guerrillas displayed a tendency to balk at hardships and a fear of being killed by the enemy.

Document also points out some experiences gained from previous guerrilla battles in the district and outlines missions to be carried out by the district until the end of 1969. These missions included efforts to control the populace, increase guerrilla strength, expand guerrilla warfare activities, and disrupt the ((GVN)) pacification program.
