15. SUMMARY:

(C) This report contains information obtained from enemy documents and concerns Directive 02/TS, dated 20 March 1969, originated by the Political Section ((A2)), S22 ((possibly Rear Service Group 82, Rear Service Staff Department, Headquarters, SVNLA)), which consists of an outline for a lecture on the border ((Vietnam-Cambodia)) area that unit commanders were to use in politically reorientating troops. The outline contains topics on the importance of K ((Cambodia)) in the political, military, and economic fields, the significance of missions on both sides of the border, the reasons why the VC live on the friendly ((Cambodian)) territory, past shortcomings with the Khmer people in the border area, and methods for implementing the directive. The directive further states that maximum efforts should be made to win the support of the K ((Cambodian)) Government and people. The report also concerns a personal history statement, dated 1 October 1969, of Le Van Cam, aka Le Thanh Cong, Company Executive Officer, Unit NL20, D260, Doan 94 ((possibly element of 260th Battalion, 9th Strategic, Security and Replacement Regiment, Headquarters, SVNLA)).
