SUBJ: (C) Communiqué, Coordination and Operations Committee, Quang Ngai Province Unit, Military Region 5.

(C) Item 1: (3 pages, typewritten; B-5) Communiqué, dated 9 Apr 69, signed by Nguyễn Chức for the Coordination and Operations Committee, Unit 130, ((aka)) Quang Ngai Province Unit, ((possibly Military Region 5)), forwarded to Quang Ngai Province Unit subordinate forces, reveals that on 13 Jan 69, the enemy ((FVMAF/RVNAF)) troops burned down six villages in the eastern zone of the border area of Binh Son and Sơn Tinh Districts. They moved the 12,000 inhabitants living there to Son Phu ((RVN)) Resettlement Center. They then transported over 1,200 of these inhabitants to the sea and killed all of them by sinking the boats on which they were aboard ((sic)). The document finally exhorts Quang Ngai Province Unit subordinate forces to avenge the above "assassinations" of their fellow countrymen committed by the enemy.

(C) Item 2: (4 pages, typewritten; B-3) Circular, dated 6 Jan 69, originated by the Political Section, Unit 130, pertains to the classification of individuals who should not be admitted to the Party. These individuals included members of ((RVN)) reactionary political parties, ((GVN)) administrative and intelligence personnel, ((RVNAF)) officers, relatives of tyrant landlords, and ((RVNAF)) noncommissioned officers and enlisted men who have been guilty of harmful acts against the Revolution. It finally directs that the admission of religious people to the Party was to be restricted. The document also contains an excerpt of Directive 121 CT/TU, originated by COSVN, governing the regulations on admission to the Party.
