15. SUMMARY

(C) This report contains information obtained from enemy documents and concerns a directive with the signature block of Huynh Binh of the Coordination and Operations Committee of Unit 123B ((possibly Political Section of the Quang Nam Province Unit, VC Military Region 5)) and an envelope which reads: H12 to K92. The directive, dated 24 July 1970, reveals that, as a result of enemy ((FWMAF/RVNAF)) psywar and Chieu Hoi activities, desertion, self-inflicted wounds, suicide, and defection had prevailed in friendly ((VC/NVA)) units. Some members had violated security regulations and provided information to the enemy. Therefore, all units were to improve security measures by countering enemy psywar and Chieu Hoi activities.
