(C-Sep 70) (2 pages, handwritten; B-3) Undated report, prepared by an unidentified individual, reveals the personnel strength of the following agencies and units ((possibly of Northern Cu Chi District, Sub-Region 1, COSVN)) as of Jun 70: District Unit, 101 members; C5 ((possibly 5th Local Force Company)), 42 members; C7 ((possibly 7th Local Force Company)), 19 members; Propaganda and Training Section, 10 members; Organization Section, three members; Security Section, 20 members; Military Proselyting Section, four members; Farmers' Association, four members; Youth Association three members; Women's Association, four members; Finance-Economy Section, four members; and the Forward Supply Council, 11 members.

Document further reveals that the following villages had a total of 295 Party members, 152 Youth Group members, 51 village guerrillas, 38 hamlet guerrillas, and 61 secret guerrillas: BH Village; TT ((possibly District seat)); TAH ((possibly Tân An Hội Village)); PH ((possibly Phước Hiệp Village)); TM ((possibly Thái Mỹ Village)); PT ((possibly Phước Thạnh Village)); TLT ((possibly Trung Lập Thượng Village)); PMH ((possibly Phú Mỹ Hưng Village)); AP ((possibly An Phú Village)); ANP ((possibly An Nhơn Tây Village)); ND ((possibly Nhuận Đức Village)); and TLH ((possibly Trung Lập Hạ Village)).

(C-Feb 70) (13 pages, handwritten, B-3) Activity plan, dated 13 Aug 70, prepared by Mười Nguyễn for the Sub-Region ((1)) Youth Group, states that in compliance with the resolution adopted by the Sub-Region ((1)) Party Committee, which directs a three-month operational phase, and Resolution III from the Central Youth Group ((COSVN)), major missions of the Sub-Region ((1)) Youth Group in Aug, Sep, and Oct 70 were to: (1) Popularize friendly ((VC/NVA)) achievements in countering ((RVN)) pacification activities, motivate Youth Group members to eliminate their shortcomings and the fear of hardships, and properly estimate the enemy in order to continue to frustrate the ((RVN)) accelerated-pacification program; (2) develop the

"Five Volunteers" movement, speed up the military, political and military proselyting activities to destroy ((RVN)) strategic hamlets and relocate the local residents, and simultaneously motivate youths to enlist in guerrilla or local force units; and (3) develop and consolidate Youth Group Chapters at all levels, and improve leadership and political training.

Youth Group members were urged to develop the guerrilla warfare movement in ((VC)) liberated areas by collecting dud shells or bombs, conducting attacks by mines and strengthening fortifications in hamlets or villages; to intensify sabotage activities in ((RVN)) strategic hamlets; and to stage political struggles against the ((RVN)) People's Self Defense Force, ((GVN)) conscription, and terrorist actions.

Document also provides guidance for conducting indoctrination training and accelerating propaganda and military proselyting activities, and states that every effort should be made to develop Four-Good-Quality Youth Group Chapters, and to motivate youths, including ((RVN)) students in weak areas or ((RVN)) strategic hamlets, to enlist in revolutionary organizations. Emphasis was also to be placed on the activation of Teenager Group Chapters in Bèn Cát, Dầu Tiếng, and Trảng Bàng Districts in Oct 70.
