SUBJ: Political Struggle Plan from Sep 70 to the End of the First Quarter of 1971, Eastern Binh Son District Party Committee, Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5. (U)

(C-Mar 71) (4 pages, typewritten; B-3) Activity Plan, number 3/VP, dated 18 Sep 70, unsigned, prepared by A25 ((possibly Political Struggle Section, Eastern Binh Son District Party Committee, Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5)), pertains to political struggles to be conducted from Sep 70 to the end of the first quarter of 1971.

According to the missions assigned by T.71B and the Current Affairs Committee, ((Eastern Binh Son)) District Party Committee, the subordinate political struggle sections from district to village and hamlet levels are to strengthen their organizations. In the liberated ((VC controlled)) areas as well as in the outskirts of ((RVN)) cities, political struggles are to be intensified in coordination with the promotion of guerrilla warfare and the motivation of the population to rise up and kill tyrants ((GVN officials)).

Document also prescribes criteria for political struggles in subordinate villages, and reveals that Binh Hiép Village is to motivate the population of My Trung, My Do and Xuan Yen ((Hamlets)) to rise up. Binh Thi Village is to develop a political struggle force. ((Binh Son)) City is to conduct political struggles in conjunction with the movement of the ((RVNAP)) disabled veterans to protest enemy ((PWNAP/RVNAP)) sweep operations and compulsory enlistment in ((RVN)) People's Self-Defense Force. Binh Long Village is to strengthen guerrilla warfare in My Yen, Long Vinh and Binh Hoi ((Hamlets)). Binh Duong Village is to motivate the population of Dong Yen and My Hue ((Hamlets)) to protest ((RVNAP)) conscription. Binh Dong Village is to motivate the population ((in unspecified RVN resettlement centers)) to return to Dung Cam and Dong Gio ((Hamlets)), and maintain control over the population of Tan Hy ((Hamlet)). Son Tra Village is to motivate the local inhabitants to rise up and kill tyrants. Thuan Phuoc Village is to maintain control over the population of Pha Le and Cay Thi ((Hamlets)). Binh Phuoc Village is to motivate the population in the Bong Trung Linh and Le Chung areas to rise up and encircle the ((RVNAP)) Trung Chanh Post.

Binh Tri Village is to promote guerrilla warfare in Phuoc Hoa, Hoa Trung, Le Thuy and An Long ((Hamlets)). Binh Hai Village is to motivate the population ((in unspecified RVN resettlement centers)) to return to the Hai Nam area, Binh Hoa Village is to increase farm production in Lac Son and An Phuoc ((Hamlets)), and Binh Thanh Village, as well as in Gia Hoi, An Hoi and An Loc ((Hamlets)). Binh Phu Village is to motivate the population ((in unspecified RVN resettlement centers)) to return to An Bang, An Hue, An Thanh and Phu Thanh ((Hamlets)) and coordinate with Binh Chau ((Hamlet)) to destroy the ((RVN)) An Son Resettlement Center.
