X. ASSAULT PROPAGANDA TEAMS  
DELIVER MRS. BINH'S MESSAGE

Continuously from 22 to 25 September, assault propaganda teams entered town N, concentration centers, and strategic hamlets along High Way #4 to read Minister Nguyen Thi Binh's statement to more than 6,200 compatriots and to hundreds of puppet soldiers in 24 posts. V. HANOI SAIGON EXCHANGE GREETINGS

A. HANOI TO SAIGON

[Hanoi in Vietnamese to South Viet-Nam, 1200 GMT, 3 October 1970]

For the tenth-anniversary of the Hanoi-Saigon-Hue brotherhood day, 8 October, the Hanoi Administrative Committee, the Hanoi Fatherland Front Committee, and the Committee for Promoting Brotherhood among Hanoi, Saigon, and Hue sent a letter to Hanoi compatriots and combatants.

The letter told of Hanoi's profound fraternal feelings for Saigon and Hue during the past 10 years. These feelings have been manifested through labor, production, combat, study, building rearline defense, and fulfillment of its duty toward the great frontline and beloved Saigon and Hue.

The letter also reflected the Hanoi troops and people's admiration for and pride in the Saigon and Hue troops and people who, in the past few years, have wholeheartedly fought for the independence, freedom, and unification of the fatherland, continually attacked, continually arisen, and repeatedly won great victories, thus contributing, along with the southern troops and people, to frustrating the U.S.-puppets' Vietnamization-of-the-war scheme and driving them into an irretrievably stalemated and defeated posture.

The Hanoi Administrative Committee, the Hanoi Fatherland Front Committee; and the Committee for Promoting Brotherhood among Hanoi, Saigon, and Hue called on the Hanoi troops and people to emulate among themselves in fulfilling their tasks in order to imbue this anniversary with the deep North-South feelings. Hanoi must continually struggle in order to be worthy of the aspirations of the South and of heroic Saigon and Hue.

For the anniversary the Thanh Cong Weaving Cooperative in Ba Dinh ward--outstanding unit of the Hanoi handicraft branch and progressive unit of the "everyone redoubles his efforts to repay his debts to the beloved southern, Saigon, and Hue kith-and-kin compatriots" emulation movement of the Hanoi industrial, small industry, and handicraft branch--and the Ngoc Ha flower-planting cooperative--outstanding unit of the Hanoi agricultural branch--were awarded the "Hanoi-Saigon-Hue Brotherhood" title.

The ceremony organized by these two cooperatives was attended by delegates of the Hanoi Administrative Committee; the Hanoi Fatherland Front Committee; the Committee for Promoting Brotherhood among Hanoi, Saigon, and Hue; the South Viet-Nam Special Representation in the DRV; the Association of Saigon Natives; and the Association of Hue Natives. Thus far, 20 production units, work units, and schools in Hanoi have been awarded the "Hanoi-Saigon-Hue Brotherhood" title.

For the anniversary, a delegation from Hanoi Radio went to the office of the South Viet-Nam Special Representation and asked the representatives to send to Liberation Radio a tape recording of the special show broadcast on the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the Hanoi-Saigon-Hue Brotherhood Day.
