SUBJ: Deactivation of the Z14 Artillery Battalion, Artillery Command, Headquarters, SVNLA. (U)

(C-Apr 71) (1 page, reproduction; B-3) Letter, dated 2 Oct 70, signed by Văn Dy ((possibly aka Nguyễn Dy, a member of the former Z14 Artillery Battalion; Artillery Command, Headquarters, SVNLA)), forwarded to Thảng ((no further information)), states that Z.14 ((possibly Z14 Artillery Battalion)) was deactivated approximately one year ago. Since the last time Dy and Thảng had been together, much had changed, because of a series of bombs of President Nixon ((sic, possibly meaning increasing airstrikes)). Dy was very happy to receive Thảng's letter in which he sent his regards to all personnel of the former Z.14. The author also states that he had been reassigned to the Political Staff ((possibly of Artillery Command, Headquarters, SVNLA)) since Mar 70. He finally suggests that whenever Dy proceeds to 64 ((possibly 64th Artillery Regiment, Artillery Command, Headquarters, of SVNLA)), he should spend an evening with Thang.
