IV. CA MAU REVOLUTIONARIES ENDORSE PRG SEPT. 17 BID

On 20 September, the NFLSV Committee and the People's Revolutionary Committee in Ca Mau province held an extraordinary meeting and issued a statement expressing unanimous agreement with the Provisional Revolutionary Government's stand at Paris, which is aimed at restoring peace in Viet-Nam. The statement stressed: "All of the Ca Mau armed forces and people are determined to exert outstanding efforts, to step up their attacks and uprisings, to assiduously build and firmly strengthen their forces, to frustrate the Americans' and puppets' special pacification scheme, and to compel them to seriously respect our people's independence and right to self-determination. If the Americans and puppets stubbornly continue to commit more crimes, the one-half million Ca Mau people vow to fight until the last drop of blood and, together with the people throughout the South, to wipe the U.S. aggressors and their lackeys, Thieu, Ky, and Khiem out of the country.
