III. LIBERATION RADIO REPORTS A
YOUTH "FOIL" PACIFICATION DIRECTIVE

[Liberation Radio, clandestine, in Vietnamese to South
Viet-Nam, 23000 GMT, 23 October 1970]

Recently, the General Executive Committee of the Vietnamese People's Revolutionary Youth Group sent instructions to cadres of all echelons, members, and youths to appeal them to concentrate on thoroughly taking advantage of every opportunity to continue to strongly step up the emulation movement to raise the "five volunteers" banner and to achieve the "four firsts" in order to defeat the Americans and to repay Uncle Ho's deeds; to actively build and develop their strength; to broadly unite all strata of youths; to thoroughly develop the shock role of members and youths on the three fronts of struggle--armed, political, and proselyting; and to contribute to defeating the Americans' and their puppets' pacification program.

Concerning the aims of the anti-pacification struggle in the coming period, the instructions clearly point out: "Resolutely foil the enemy's deceitful and demagogic forms of propaganda, oppose psywar and 'open-arms' activities, destroy the enemy's reactionary political organizations, destroy the civil-defense corps, thoroughly oppose pressganging and the increase of the enemy troops' strength, and especially oppose the turning of civil-defense corpsmen into militiamen and civil guards.
