(C-Nov 72) Item 1: (2 pages, handwritten; B-3) Report, dated 15 May 72, prepared by Lê Thị Dữ, for an unspecified addressee; pertains to activities of the Security Section of AT-16 ((unspecified village Party Committee, Phong Điền District, Thừa Thiên Province, VC Tri-Thiên-Huế Region)) during the period 1 to 15 May 72. The Security Section of AT-16 had detected 22 ((RVN)) Vietnamese Nationalist Party members, reeducated five reactionaries, and consolidated ((VC)) security elements in Phố Ninh, Đông Gia, and Thượng An Hamlets.

The reverse side of the document records the names and positions of 20 ((RVN)) village administrative officials and ((RVN)) policemen.

(C-Aug 72) Item 2: (2 pages, handwritten; B-3) Letter, dated 25 May 72, signed by Danh for LN 7 ((possibly the Security Section, Phong Điền District Party Committee)), addressed to the security cadre of ATs ((possibly villages of Phong Điền District)), reads in part as follows: "LN7 has sent to you a guideline issued by B5-A300 ((unidentified)) concerning security tasks. Plans should be formulated to keep track of those individuals who were targeted for assassination ((by the VC)). In addition, proselyting letters should be sent to ((RVNAF)) officers and soldiers. A report concerning the enemy, the civilian population, and friendly ((VC)) security activities should be submitted to me immediately."

(C-Jul 72) Items 3-4: (5 pages, handwritten and printed; B-3) Circular with envelope, classified ((VC)) SECRET, dated 30 Apr 72, from LN 7, addressed to Bang of AT-15 ((unspecified village Party Committee, Phong Điền District, Thừa Thiên Province)), provides guidelines on the security missions to be carried out in the villages which would be liberated ((by the VC)).

Emphasis was to be placed on killing tyrants, and investigating all Fws, defectors, and deserters. Measures were to be taken against ((RVN)) officials, spies, and intelligence agents. Efforts should be made to capture enemy documents, weapons, cameras, radios, and telephones; motivate

the villagers to secretly denounce ((RVN)) informants; coordinate activities of security and guerrilla elements to detect the infiltration of ((RVN)) intelligence agents into revolutionary organizations; thoroughly search ((RVN)) local officials' and tyrants' houses; and maintain security in friendly base areas.
