The political training lessons recorded in the document deal with military proselyting activities; motivation of the population to rise up; farmer, youth, and women proselyting; propaganda and organization activities; and political struggle activities.

An entry, dated 5 Mar 72, pertains to a political indoctrination course conducted to study Directive 1/CT/PK/72 from the ((Ba Ria)) Sub-Region Party Committee concerning the intensification of civilian proselyting activities in the first six months of 1972 in order to seize and maintain control over the population.

An entry, dated 23 May 72, reveals that a meeting was held by 17 members of the ((Long Thanh)) District Party Committee, ((Ba Ria Sub-Region)), to review past military activities. This entry reveals that in the last six months of ((1971)), the ((Long Thanh)) District Unit fought a total of 11 battles (including seven attacks by fire), assassinated six tyrants ((GVN officials)), and recruited ten youths from An Hoa, Lóc An, Tam An, FH ((unidentified)), and An Lợi Villages, ((Long Thanh District)).

Notes recorded on 24 May 72 reveal that a Party chapter of three members was activated in Hung Hoa Village, and a Party chapter of three female members was activated in an unidentified village.

An entry, dated 5 Jun 72, indicates that a meeting was held by the Tam Phước Village Party Chapter to assess the enemy ((FMAP/RVNAP)) and friendly ((VC)) situations, discuss the activation of an uprising section in Tam Phước Village, and formulate an activity plan for the motivation of the population ((to rise up)) in May and Jun ((72)).

An undated entry indicates that Long Phước Village had seven Youth Group members; Long An Village, four Youth Group members; An Lợi Village, seven Youth Group members; FH ((unidentified)) Village, two Youth Group members; T ((Tam)) Phước Village, five female Youth Group members; An Hoa Village, three female Youth Group members; and Lóc An Village, six Youth Group members.
