HANOI CONDEMNS SAIGON STATEMENT ON INTERVENING IN CAMBODIA

Hanoi in Vietnamese to Vietnam 0000 GMT 28 June 73 S

[Text] According to AFP, Buu Bao Truc, spokesman of the Saigon administration, brazenly stated on 27 June that South Vietnam would intervene militarily in Cambodia. He stated: If the U.S. air support were ended and if this act should create a serious situation that may endanger South Vietnam's security, South Vietnam--that is, the Saigon administration--would certainly meet the requirements of Cambodia, that is, the puppet Lon Nol clique.

This statement by the Saigon administration's spokesman once again proves that with the U.S. encouragement and despite the condemnation of mankind, the Saigon administration still clings to its aggressive designs against Cambodia and tramples on its own pledges in the Paris agreement and 13 June joint communique. We strongly condemn this adventurous act of the Saigon administration and tell it that it should not play with fire--its adventurous acts can only bring it more bitter defeats.
