CORRESPONDENT'S VISIT TO QUANG TRI REPORTED

[Text] Hanoi, July 2, 1973 (HSINHUA correspondent)--We paid a visit to the liberated area of Quang Tri Province in South Vietnam at a time when the Vietnamese people were celebrating the fourth anniversary of the founding of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam and hailing their great victory in the war against U.S. aggression and for national salvation.

Situated close to the 17th Parallel, Quang Tri Province is of strategic importance. It is here where the South Vietnam People's Liberation Armed Forces dealt heavy blows at the enemy and won one victory after another. By January 27 when the Paris agreement was signed, 85 percent of the land in the province had been liberated.
